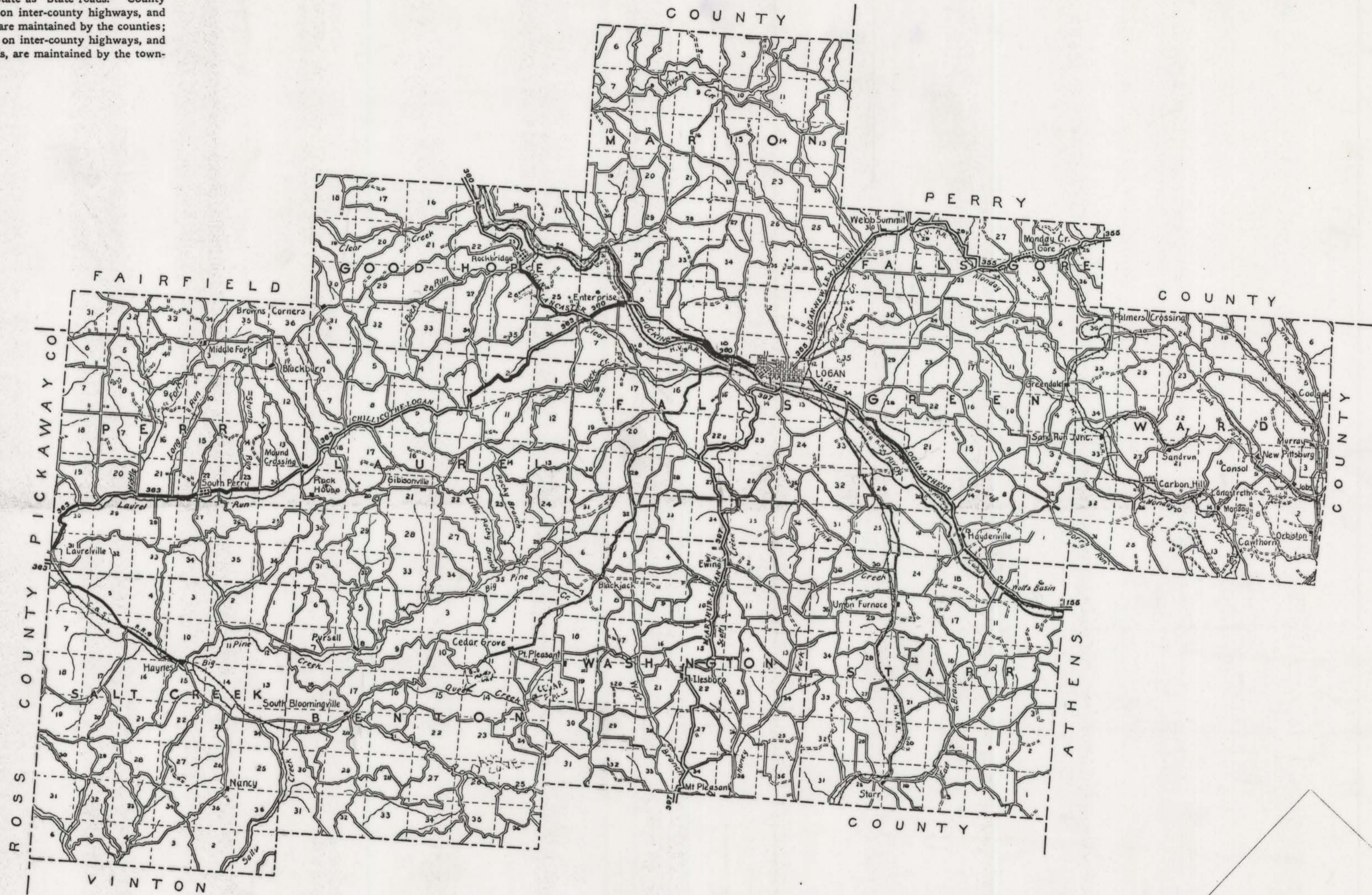


EXPLANATION.

Inter-county highways are shown on this map by heavy lines and by their official names and numbers. Improvements on inter-county highways built by the State, or "taken over" by the State, are maintained by the State as "State roads." County road improvements on inter-county highways, and other county roads, are maintained by the counties; and township roads on inter-county highways, and other township roads, are maintained by the townships.
