To whom it may concern: I hereby certify that by request of Allan Strous of the County of Hocking and State of Ohio, I have laid out a parcel of land (7 1/2 acres), known as part of the southwest quarter of Section 31 Township 12 Range 19, Chillicothe Land District, into 19 lots, 1 alley, 2 avenues and two streets, also two acres designated A & B and marked Sol Reigle, R. Dodson, J. Steel, James Steel, Henry Jones and Isaac Bigham, and which may be numbered (for the purposes of taxation and assessment,) at the discretion of the recorder or auditor; also 8 acres more or less lying east of the Singleville and Sattercock Valley Turnpike, north of the so-called Mill road to Logan, and south of Albin and M. Daniel's line divided into 4 out lots, numbered 1, 2, 3, & 4, notes of all which are fully set forth in the accompanying Map of Allen Strous' Addition to the town of Laurelville Hocking County Ohio.
