The Board of County Commissioners of Hocking County, Ohio, met in regular session on the 22nd day of February, 1973, with the following members present: Otto Shaw, James McLain, and John Bumgardner.

Mr. James McLain introduced a motion for authorization of the annexation of 18 acres more or less in Falls Township to the City of Logan, Ohio, in accordance with a petition filed with said Board on December 20, 1972, and for which a hearing was held on February 21, 1973:

Now, therefore, in consideration of said motion said Board, its full membership concurring finds as follows:

A. Said petition contains all matter required in Section 709.02 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

B. Notice has been published as required by Section 709.031 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

C. The persons whose names are subscribed to the petition are owners of real estate located in the territory described in the petition, and as of the time the petition was filed with the Board of Commissioners, the number of valid signatures on the petition constituted a majority of the owners of real estate in the territory proposed to be annexed and;

D. The territory included in the annexation petition is not unreasonably large, the map of said territory is accurate and the general good of the territory sought to be annexed will be served if the annexation petition is granted.

ORDINANCE NO. 20, 1973
CITY OF LOGAN, OHIO

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING ANNEXATION ON APPLICATION OF THE OWNERS OF REAL ESTATE IN FALLS TOWNSHIP TO THE CITY OF LOGAN, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, a Petition for the annexation of certain territory in Falls Township was duly filed by Oscar Bartholomew and others; and

Whereas, the said Petition was duly considered by the Board of Commissioners of Hocking County, Ohio, on the 22nd day of February, 1973; and

Whereas, the said Board of County Commissioners has approved the annexation of said territory to the City of Logan, Ohio, as hereinafter described;

and Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Hocking County, Ohio, certified the transcript of the proceedings in connection with said annexation with the map and Petition required in connection therewith to the Clerk of the City of Logan, Ohio, who received the same on the 27th day of February, 1973;

and Whereas, sixty days from the date of said filing have now elapsed in accordance with the provisions of Section 709.04 of the Revised Code of Ohio;

now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOGAN, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the proposed annexation as applied for in the Petition of Oscar Bartholomew and a majority of the owners of real estate in the territory sought to be annexed and filed with the Board of County Commissioners, of Hocking County, Ohio, on the 29th day of December, 1972, and which said Petition prayed for annexation to the City of Logan, Ohio, certain territory

adjacent thereto as hereinafter described, and which said Petition was approved for annexation to the City of Logan, Ohio, by the Board of County Commissioners of Hocking County, Ohio, on the 22nd day of February, 1973, be and the same is hereby accepted. Said territory is described as follows:

Situated in the Township of Falls, Hocking County, Ohio:

Beginning at a point on present corporation line, said point being the Southwest corner of Lot #30 of the Bell and Scholl Allotment; thence East along the present corporation line 2150' more or less to the Northwest corner of the intersection of Elm Street and County Road 33A Chieftain Drive (said present corporation line is the North line of County Road 33A); thence South along the present corporation line 60' more or less to the South line of County Road 33A (said line is present corporation line); thence West along present corporation line 1270' more or less to a point on the West line of County Road 33A; thence South along the West line of County Road 33A, 370' more or less to the center line of the Hocking River; thence with the center line of Hocking River in a westerly direction 1460' more or less to the East Right of Way line of State Route 664; thence with the East Right of Way line of State Route 664, 740' more or less to the South line of County Road 33A; thence East with the South line of County Road 33A, 130' more or less to a point; thence North 60' more or less to the place of beginning, containing 18 acres more or less.

The certified transcript of the proceedings for annexation with an accurate map of said territory, and other papers relating to the proceedings thereto of said County Commissioners are all on file with the Clerk of the City of Logan, Ohio, and have been for more than sixty days.

Section 2. That the City Clerk be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to make three copies of this Ordinance to each of which shall

be attached a copy of the map accompanying the Petition for annexation, a copy of the transcript of proceedings of the Board of County Commissioners relating thereto and a certificate as to the correctness thereof. The Clerk shall then forthwith deliver one copy to the County Auditor, one copy to the County Recorder, and one copy to the Secretary of State of Ohio, and shall file notice of this annexation with the Board of Elections within thirty days after it becomes effective, and said Clerk shall do all other things required by law.
