I know all men by these presents that Jacob Mitchell of the County of Hocking of Swann Township in the State of Ohio of the first part for the consideration of Fifty cents paid in hand do hereby lease unto Simeon Briggs Jason Samphear and Thomas Rannels directors of School District No 1 in Swann and Brown Townships Hocking County Ohio party of the second part and their successors and assigns the following parcel of land commencing opposite to the walnut tree thence running north along the road three rods thence running East three rods thence running south three rods along Rannels line thence running west three rods to the place of beginning with all privileges and appurtenances. To have and to hold the same for and during the term of for as long as the district sees fit to hold a school there from the 1st day January 1847.
