 from all incumbrances whatsoever and that he will forever warrant and defend  
 the same with the appurtenances unto the said Wilford Stiers his heirs and assigns  
 against the lawful claims of all persons whatsoever and the said Wilford Stiers  
 for himself and heirs doth further covenant with the said Joseph D Wolf his heirs and  
 assigns that they shall have from the Canal Bridge partly standing on the of said  
 Lot a right of way through that part of the aforesaid Lot which lies between  
 the Canal and the line B. C as shown by the annexed plat without any in-  
 cumbrance to the said Joseph D Wolf by any incumbrance put upon the said Lot by  
 the said Stiers the point B shown by a stone planted 57 links from East of the  
 the Beginning and it is further agreed that each possess equal rights to the Bridge
