

Plat and Description of West Logan

The land embraced in the annexed plat of West Logan is described as follows:

Being part of Lot Eleven (11) Section Ten (10), Township Fourteen (14), Range Seventeen (17) and bounded by beginning at a stone at point marked A and running Two and five hundredths (2.05) chains; Thence $S 72\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$ twenty and seventy four hundredths (20.74) chains; Thence $S 25^{\circ} W$ Two and Twenty seven hundredths (2.27) chains; Thence $S 51\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W$ Four and fifty hundredths (4.50) chains; Thence $S 54\frac{3}{4}^{\circ} W$ Six and eighteen hundredths (6.18) chains; Thence $N 9^{\circ} W$ nine and ten hundredths (9.10) chains; Thence $N 6^{\circ} W$ Four and thirty two hundredths (4.32) chains; Thence $N 18^{\circ} E$ Six and seventy seven hundredths (6.77) chains; Thence $N 54\frac{3}{4}^{\circ} W$ Three and twenty six hundredths (3.26) chains; to point of commencement.

I hereby certify that the plat hereon is a correct one as I verily believe; that that part of Lot Eleven (11) above described lying E of M^cBarthur road and S of H. B. Ry a distance of five hundred and eighty (580) feet from center of Ry track has been divided into fifty five (55) lots and numbered consecutively with bounds as marked. That I have placed a permanent stone at point marked B, from which the parallel division lines of lots are at distances as marked. That I have placed at intersections of Homer St. and Central Ave. a stone which marks the correct crossing of center line of said Sts. That I have placed stones at the several corners of Out Lots lettered V, X, Y, Z the contents of said Out Lots being given on plat.
