3) South 51 degrees 27 minutes 20 seconds West a distance of 297.13 feet to a Point;
4) South 72 degrees 39 minutes 10 seconds West a distance of 88.89 feet to a Point;
5) North 87 degrees 45 minutes 00 seconds West a distance of 16.11 feet to the point of beginning and containing 2.250 acres, more or less, subject to any public or private easements of record.

The above 2.250 acre survey was based upon information obtained from tax maps, deed descriptions, previous surveys, existing monumentation, and an existing private road.
