2) S 66 degrees $40^{\prime} 25^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$ a distance of 109.96 ft . to a point;
3) S 59 degrees $30^{\prime} 37^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$ a distance of 50.70 ft , to a point on the south line of Sec. 29;

Thence, leaving Co. Rd. 11 and with said south line, N 84 degrees $54^{\prime} 49^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$, passing an iron pin set at 33.75 ft ., going a total distance of 105.73 ft . to the Place of Beginning, containing 0.8033 acre in O.R. 662, Pg. 460, and 2.8699 acres out of O.R. 53 , pg. 844 , making a total of 3.6732 acres, more or less, and being subject to the rights-of-way of 60 ft . wide Twp. Rd. 48, 60 ft . wide Co. Rd. 11, and all valid easements.
