- 4) With a curve to the right having a delta angle of 35° 03' 17", a radius of 110.98 feet, and an arc length of 67.90 feet a chord bearing N 31° 51' 17" E and a chord distance of 66.85 feet to a point;
- 5) N 49° 22' 55" E a distance of 129.89 feet to a point;
- 6) S 52° 49' 08" W a distance of 12.08 feet to a point;
- 7) With a curve to the left having a delta angle of 31° 01' 49", a radius of 123.82 feet, a curve length of 67.06 feet a chord bearing S 68° 20' 02" E a chord distance of 66.24 feet to a point;
- 8) S 83° 50' 57" E a distance of 44.02 feet to a point;

9) With a curve to the right having a delta angle of 98° 17' 12", a radius of 125.55 feet, a curve length of 215.36 feet a chord bearing N 34° 42' 21" E a chord distance of 189.91 feet to a point, said point being on the Grantor's Southerly property line, the Northerly property line of a parcel of land conveyed to Hawking Hills Cabins, LLC as recorded in Official Record 694, Page 284 and the terminus point of said easement containing 0.1836 Acres, more or less, and subject to all legal easements and rights of way of record.

Bearings are based on the Ohio State Plane Coordinate System, South Zone, NAD83 (NSRS 2007). Said bearings originated from ODOT CORS VRS network. The portion of the west line of Section 19, Township 12, Range 19, having a bearing of N 03° 02' 50" E is designated the "basis of bearing" for this survey.
