LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Hocking, Township of Laurel and being a part of an 82.16 acre parcel of land known as the First Tract and located in the west half of the northwest quarter of Section 27, Township 12, Range 18, Congress Lands, as conveyed to Goldie Marie Rowland (hereinafter referred to as "Grantor") in Deed Volume 114, Page 598, all records of the Recorder's Office, Hocking County, Ohio and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a railroad spike set in the center of Cream Ridge Road (Township Road 219), said railroad spike being the northeast corner of the west half of the northwest quarter of Section 27, the Grantor's northeasterly property corner, the southeasterly property corner of a 12.00 acre parcel of land as conveyed to Crane Hollow, Inc. in Deed Volume 199, Page 474, and the northwesterly property corner of a 1.00 acre parcel of land as conveyed to Linn E. and Nancy Altman in Deed Volume 107 Page 671;

Thence S 5° 00' 41" W along the centerline of Cream Ridge Road, the easterly line of the west half of the northwest quarter of Section 27, the Grantor's easterly property line, the westerly property lines of the aforementioned Altman parcel, a 56.00 acre parcel of land as conveyed to Bernard and Goldie Russel in Deed Volume 85, Page 296, a 100.00 acre parcel of land as conveyed to Alice M. Carroll in Deed Volume 136, Page 347, a distance of 1998.65 feet to a nail set, said nail being the southeasterly corner of the parcel herein described;

Thence through the Grantor's lands and along the center of a gravel road the following three (3) courses:

- 1) S 89° 22' 45" W a distance of 202.51 feet to an iron pin set (passing an iron pin set at 20.00 feet);
- 2) S 71° 00' 55" W a distance of 283.59 feet to an iron pin set;
- 3) S 73° 00' 20" W a distance of 150.35 feet to an iron pin set, said iron pin being the southwesterly corner of the parcel herein described;

Thence N 5° 00' 41" E and continuing through the Grantor's lands a distance of 2194.47 feet to an iron pin set, said iron pin being on the Grantor's northerly property line, the northerly line of Section 27, the southerly property line of the aforementioned Crane Hollow, Inc. parcel and the northwesterly corner of the parcel herein described;

Thence S 84° 34' 44" E along the northerly line of Section 27, the Grantor's northerly property line, and the southerly property line of the aforementioned Crane Hollow, Inc. parcel a distance of 600.01 feet (passing iron pins found at 38.96 feet and 464.05 feet) to the point of beginning, containing 28.589 acres, more or less, and subject to all legal easements and rights of way of record.
