Dear Mr. Weinrich:

At request of Mr. James Kreig, the following information, concerning property lines and certain corners for parts of Lots 163 and 164, including Canal Land, High Street, Logan City, as well as several deed references, is respectfully submitted to you.

- (a) On November 29, 1941, I set corners for Lot 607, then owned by Alice Koppe, and now by Minerva Helber. The east line of Lot 607 is common with the west line of Lots 163 and 164 as platted in Village Plat Book 1, Page 5.
- (b) On December 27, 1952, I set the southwest corner of the James Kreig property. This corner lies on the east line of Lot 607 as surveyed for Koppe and is nominally 19' 8" south of the northwest corner of Lot 164. The corner is an X cut in the top of the sewer which follows generally the center line of the abandoned Hocking Canal.
- (c) It should be noted in the purchases of canal land that an iron pin cited in the James Kreig deed, Volume 81, Page 186, is identical with the iron pin cited in the Margaret Malloy deed, Volume 62, Page 66. The survey line runs from the cited iron pin to the X mentioned in paragraph b, is parallel to the side lines of Lots 163 and 164. This survey line should divide that portion of Lot 164 now owned by Minerva Helber from the James Kreig property. The canal property line pin is preserved and was used in my survey, item b.
- (d) A double line of titles appears in the Deed Record for Lot 164. The cause for the double line of titles is substantially as follows:

Ruth W. Brown from Chas. Wright, Dec'd., Lot 164 and part of Lot 163, Vol. 48, Page 340.

Ruth Brown to Carl and Matel Brandt, part Lot 163, Volume 48, Page 570. (Note) No mention is made of Lot 164. As is developed in later conveyances, this transaction should also have conveyed a part of Lot 164.

Ruth Brown to Ceo. and Margaret Malloy; being Lot 164 except that part conveyed to Carl and Mabel Brandt, Volume 54, Page 28. (Note) The exception herein indicates that part of Lot 164 was conveyed to Carl and Mabel Brandt.

The Brandt property through conveyances recorded Volume 50, Page 1, and Volume 51, Page 627, became the property of L. J. Quinn.

L. J. Quinn by Court Decree, October 5, 1927, received 19' - 8" off the north side of Lot 164. (See Volume 62, Page 38, and a correction in Volume 62, Page 201.)

On the Malloy side of the matter:

Geo. Malloy to Margaret Malloy Volume 54, Page 34.

By conveyance recorded in Volume 65, Page 193, Margaret Malloy conveyed to Myrtle Smith, in part as follows: Being a part of Lot 164, beginning at Southwest corner of Lot East 74 feet, North 68 - 6", West 74 feet, and South 68 - 6".

By conveyance, recorded in Volume 86, Page 14, Mv.tle Smith conveyed the above parcel to Minerva Helber, the present owner.

The calls North 68' - 6" and South 68' - 6" in the Malloy to Smith conveyance is the cause for the double line of titles.

(a) The nominal width of Lot 164 is 74.25 feet (74' - 3"). By Court action, Kreig has 19' - 8" off north side of Lot 164, leaving Malloy nominally 54' - 7".

Further, Malloy in conveyance, Volume 62, Page 66, received canal ground from the City of Legan, the nominal width of which, although indirectly stated, is 54' - 7".

(f) The actual width of the canal land purchased by Malloy as defined by canal property line pin is 53.07 feet (53' - 1" very nearly).

A sketch is enclosed of part of Butin and Fellows Addition, Village Plat Book 1, Page 5, showing Lots 163-164 and 607 on which is superimposed canal land and present ownership property lines.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED ALLEY VACATION

Being a part of the City of Logan Alley platted as "Canal Alley" on the recorded plat of the "F. Case Addition" to the City of Logan as delineated in Village Plat Bk. 1, Pgs. 27-29, situated in Sec. 11, Falls Twp., T-14N, R-17W, City of Logan, Hocking County, Ohio. The boundaries of said vacation tract are described as follows:

Beginning at a 5/8" iron pin found on the SW corner of Lot No. 69 of said F. Case Addition (now known as Lot No. 282);

Thence with the east line of Canal alley, S 0 degrees 16' 37" E, passing a point on the south line of the canal tract described in Deed Vol. 137, Pg. 699, at 62.78 ft. and passing a point on the southerly line of Lot No. 811 of the Culver and Vorys assignees of Gallagher and Friesner Addition (Village Plat Bk. 2, Pgs. 119-120) at 131.75 ft., going a total distance of 171.40 ft. to a point on the south line of said "F. Case's Addition";

Thence, with said south line, S 89 degrees 43' 23" W a distance of 24.75 ft. to a point at the SW corner of said Canal Alley;

Thence, with the west line of said alley, N 0 degrees 16' 37" W, passing a point on the easterly right-of-way line of Second St. at 11.27 ft. and passing a point on the northerly line of the canal tract described in Deed Vol. 137, Pg. 699, at 153.08 ft., going a total distance of 171.40 ft. to a point;

Thence, N 89 degrees 43' 23" E a distance of 24.75 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 0.0974 acre, more or less.

Cited bearings are based on monumentation found on the north line of the Hocking Canal as running N 72 degrees 30' 24" E.



DESCRIPTION OF SURVEY FOR MRS. MICHELLE CRIST

Being the tract of land last transferred in Vol. 586, Pg. 410, Hocking County Official Records, consisting of all of Lot No. 811 and part of Lot 810 of the L.A. Culver, A.J. Vorhees, and Frank Gallagher's addition (Village Plat Bk. 2, Pgs. 119 and 120), part of Lot No. 685 of the Logan Iron Company's Addition (Village of Plat Bk. 1, Pg. 98), part of a vacated (City Ordinance 2, 2021) 24.75 ft. wide alley know as "Canal Alley", and part of the abandoned Hocking Canal, situated in Sec. 11, Falls Twp., T-14N, R-17W, Hocking County, City of Logan Ohio, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the easterly right-of-way line of Second St., said point being the southern-most corner of Lot No. 811;

Thence, with said easterly right-of-way line, N 41 degrees 50' 32" W, passing the westernmost corner of said Lot 811 and a point on the south line of the abandoned Hocking Canal at 54.78 ft., going a total distance of 69.39 ft. to an iron pin set;

Thence, continuing with the east right-of-way line of Second St., N 0 degrees 16' 37" W a distance of 18.18 ft. to an iron pin set on the southern-most corner of the 0.1167 Ac. tract described in Deed Vol. 137, Pg. 699;

Thence, leaving Second St. and with the south line of said tract, N 71 degrees 59' 24" E, passing a point on the west line of Lot 685 and a point on the west line of Canal Alley at 51.69 ft. and passing a point on the east line of said Canal Alley at 77.67 ft., going a total distance of 109.65 ft. to an iron pin set;

Thence, with east line of said 0.1167 Ac. tract, N 17 degrees 39' 36" W a distance of 31.43 ft. to an iron pin set on the south line of a 20.0 ft. wide alley, said pin being referenced by an iron bolt found on the north line of the abandoned Hocking Canal which bears N 17 degrees 39' 36" W a distance of 18.07 ft.;

Thence with the south right-of-way line of said 20.0 ft. alley the following two (2) courses:

- 1) S 82 degrees 32' 25" E a distance of 40.15 ft. to an iron pin set;
- 2) S 71 degrees 50' 56" E a distance of 42.63 ft. to an iron pin set on the northwesterly corner of the tracts described in O.R. Vol.163, Pg. 380;

Thence with the boundaries of said O.R. 163, Pg. 380, the following (3) courses:

- 1) S 48 degrees 09' 28" W a distance of 46.74 ft. to an iron pin set on the south line of the abandoned Hocking Canal;
- 2) With said south line, S 65degrees 07' 52" E a distance of 4.90 ft. to an iron pin set;
- 3) Leaving said canal line, S 48 degrees 09' 28" W a distance of 127.94 to a point on the easterly right-of-way line of Second St., said point being in a concrete drive and being referenced by an iron pin set which bears S 48 degrees 42' 35' W a distance of 6.39 ft.;

Thence, with said easterly right-of-way line, N 41 degrees 50' 32" W a distance of 4.50 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 0.2303 acre, more or less, and being subject to all valid easements.

Cited bearings are based monumentation found on the north line of the Hocking Canal as running N 72 degrees 30' 24" E.

All iron pins described as being set are 5/8" X 30" with a 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " plastic I.D. cap stamped "M.P.B. S-6803".
