MARION TOWNSHIP, HOCKING COUNTY, OHIO

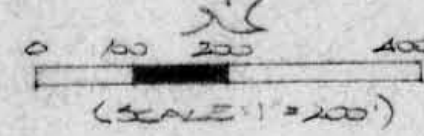
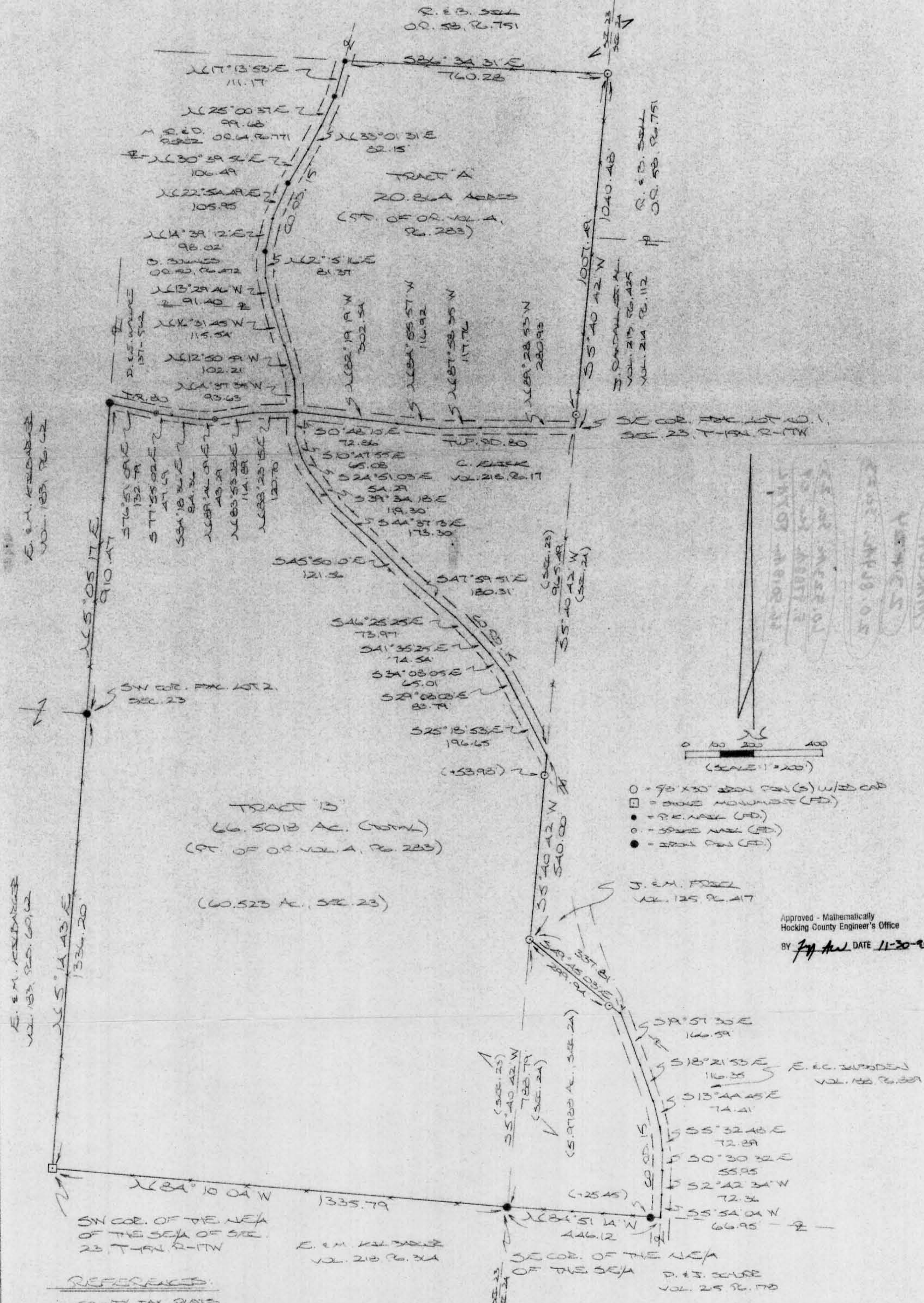
