Thence North 04 degrees 07 minutes 00 seconds East a distance of 151.36 feet to a $5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ iron pin set on the north line of the East half of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter; Thence North 89 degrees 43 minutes 10 seconds East a distance of 218.42 feet, passing a $5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ iron pin with $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ plastic ID cap stamped LS-6344 found at a distance of 188.42 feet, to the point of beginning and containing 1.000 acres more or less, subject to the public easement of said Township Road 201 (Pleasant Ridge Road) and any other public or private easements of record.
