Description of original monument and accessories and subsequent restorations: Original corner believed to have been established by John Mathewson in 1797.

Corner reestablished by Levi Davis survey of township 13 range 15 in 1870. Established following bearing trees: 10 inch White Oak N32 ${ }^{\circ}$ W 99 inks, 20 inch Red Oak S36 ${ }^{\circ} \mathrm{W} 150$ 1 inks.

In 1937 Forest Service Surveyor Singleton found this corner to be marked by a stone. Established following bearing trees: 16 inch Tulip Poplar $534^{\circ} \mathrm{W}$ 45.2 feet, 10 inch Walnut $572^{\circ} \mathrm{E} 32.7$ feet, 3 inch Oak $\mathrm{N} 88^{\circ}{ }^{\circ} \mathrm{W} 38.9$ feet.

Description of corner evidence found:
Found set stone with an ' X '. Also, found 10 inch Walnut (down) $572^{\circ} \mathrm{E} 33$ feet, and a 24 inch Tulip Poplar $534^{\circ} \mathrm{W} 45.5$ feet. These are bearing trees from the 1937 Forest Service survey. Also found metal sign on a Hickory west 21 feet corner position is further verified by examining aerial photos of the area.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:
Set 2 inch $x 48$ inch iron pipe filled with concrete with a brass cap on top adjacent to and 0.6 feet south of ' $X$ ' on stone. Established following bearing trees:

Thence S $03^{\circ} 43^{\prime} 00^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} 199.74$ feet along the north line of United States of America as recorded in D.R. 244, pg. 385 parcel 2 to an iron pin found;

Thence N $85^{\circ} 32^{\prime} 52^{\prime \prime}$ W 1097.24 feet along a northern line of United States of America as recorded in D.R. 244, pg. 385 parcel 2 to an iron pin found;

Thence S $04^{\circ} 28^{\prime} 53^{\prime \prime}$ W 1208.53 feet along the west line of United States of America as recorded in D.R. 244, pg. 385 parcel 2 to the southwest corner of United States of America as recorded in D.R. 244, Pg. 385 parcel 2 also being a point on the south line Section 26, a point on the north line of Section 25 and the north line of United States of America as recorded in O.R. $95, \mathrm{Pg} .852$ passing an iron pin found at 1193.40 feet;

Thence N $85^{\circ} 17^{\prime} 04^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} 5347.76$ feet along the south line of Section 32 also being the north line of United States of America as recorded in D.R. 364, Pg. 2434 and the north line of Section 31 to an iron pin found at the southwest corner of Section 32 also being the northwest corner of Section 31, a point on the west line of Athens County and the northwest corner of Elle Dee McCall, James Arthur McCall, Judith Sue McCall Campbell and Robert D. McCall as recorded in D.R. 355, Pg. 191 passing an iron pin found at 1320.54 feet, 0.93 feet left and a stone found at 2675.00 feet 0.96 feet left;

Thence $\mathrm{N} 03^{\circ} 47^{\prime} 25^{\prime \prime}$ E 1149.93 feet along the east line of United States of America as recorded in D.R. 179, Pg. 206 to a railroad spike set in the centerline of Goose Run Road passing an iron pin set at 1119.93 feet;

6. Along a curve to the left 81.51 feet, having a radius of 197.34 feet, a central angle of $23^{\circ} 39^{\prime} 59^{\prime \prime}$ and a chord bearing of $\mathrm{N} 74^{\circ} 06^{\prime} 18^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E} 80.93$ feet to a point;
7. $\mathrm{N} 62^{\circ} 16^{\prime} 18^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E} 592.72$ feet to a point;
8. N $59^{\circ} 56^{\prime} 45^{\prime \prime}$ E 169.37 feet to a point;
9. Along a curve to the left 317.60 feet, having a radius of 910.45 feet, a central angle of $19^{\circ} 59^{\prime} 12^{\prime \prime}$ and a chord bearing of $\mathrm{N} 49^{\circ} 57^{\prime} 09^{\prime \prime}$ E 315.99 feet to a point;
10. N $39^{\circ} 57^{\prime} 33^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E} 343.92$ feet to a point;
11. N $51^{\circ} 19^{\prime} 57^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E} 129.33$ feet to a point;
12. N $55^{\circ} 19^{\prime} 24^{\prime \prime}$ E 67.01 feet to a point;
13. Along a curve to the right 240.32 feet, having a radius of 320.41 feet, a central angle of $42^{\circ} 58^{\prime} 24^{\prime \prime}$ and a chord bearing of $N 76^{\circ} 48^{\prime} 36^{\prime \prime}$ E 234.72 feet to a point;
14. Along a curve to the right 221.58 feet, having a radius of 1020.76 feet, a central angle of $12^{\circ} 26^{\prime} 14^{\prime \prime}$ and a chord bearing of $S 75^{\circ} 29^{\prime} 05^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E} 221.14$ feet to a point;
15. S $69^{\circ} 15^{\prime} 58^{\prime \prime}$ E 258.34 feet to a point;
16. Along a curve to the left 319.23 feet, having a radius of 1034.78 feet, a central angle of $17^{\circ} 40^{\prime} 32^{\prime \prime}$ and a chord bearing of $S 78^{\circ} 06^{\prime} 14^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E} 317.96$ feet to a point;
17. S $86^{\circ} 56^{\prime} 30^{\prime \prime}$ E 135.32 feet to a point;
18. Along a curve to the right 164.23 feet, having a radius of 300.00 feet, a central angle of $31^{\circ} 21^{\prime} 54^{\prime \prime}$ and a chord bearing of $S 71^{\circ} 15^{\prime} 33^{\prime \prime}$ E 162.18 feet to a point;
19. S $55^{\circ} 34^{\prime} 36^{\prime \prime}$ E 135.79 feet to a point;
20. Along a curve to the right 131.43 feet, having a radius of 324.84 feet, a central angle of $23^{\circ} 10^{\prime} 56^{\prime \prime}$ and a chord bearing of $S 43^{\circ} 59^{\prime} 08^{\prime \prime}$ E 130.54 feet to a railroad spike set on the east line of Section 32 also being the west line of Section 26 , the grantor's east line of parcel 2 and the grantor's west line of parcel 1;

Thence $\mathrm{N} 03^{\circ} 36^{\prime} 15^{\prime \prime}$ E 1081.99 feet along the east line of Section 32 also being the west line of Section 26, the grantor's east line of parcel 2 and the grantor's west line of parcel l passing an iron pin set at 30.00 feet to the Point of Beginning.

The above described contains 966.691 acres more or less excepting a 0.988 acre tract for Rush Cemetery leaving 965.703 acres ( 412.242 acres in Auditor's Parcel Number M01-00100724-00 and 553.461 acres in Auditor's Parcel Number M01-00100726-00).

Subject to all legal easements and rights of way including a 0.988 acre Bethel Ridge Cemetery described as follows;

Commencing at an iron pin set at the corner common to Sections 26, 32, 33 and Auditor's Section 27. Said iron pin being the grantor's northeast corner as recorded in D.R. 127, Pg. 638 parcel 2, the northwest corner of The Sunday Creek Coal Company as recorded in D.R. 127, Pg. 638 parcel 1, the southeast corner of The Sunday Creek Coal Company as recorded in D.R. 127, Pg. 638 parcel 3 and the southwest corner of The Sunday Creek Coal Company as recorded in D.R. 127, Pg. 638 parcel 4, thence S $23^{\circ} 48^{\prime} 49^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} 1594.05$ feet along a random line to a point in Township Road 304A. Said point being the Point of Beginning for the tract herein described;

Thence from this Point of Beginning along a line common to The Sunday Creek Coal Company the following five courses;

1. N $47^{\circ} 46^{\prime} 56^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} 317.80$ feet to an iron pin set (passing an iron pin set at 20.91 feet);

3. N $76^{\circ} 59^{\prime} 03^{\prime \prime}$ E 77.24 feet to an iron pin set;

5. N $88^{\circ} 13^{\prime} 04^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} 109.15$ feet to the Point of Beginning.

The bearings are Ohio State Plane Grid (Ohio South Zone NAD83(95).
All distances are grid. To obtain ground distances multiply each distance by 1.00010639 .
All iron pins set are $3 / 4$ " x 30 " rebar with a 2 " aluminum cap stamped "Canter PS 7226".
Plat of survey is attached herewith and made a part thereof.
