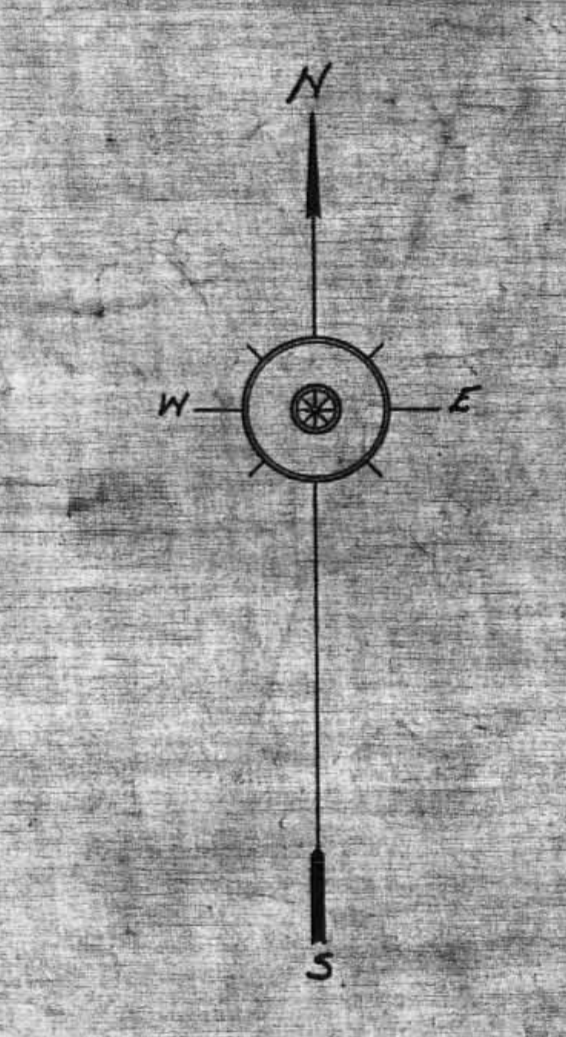




I Gregory K. Wright, do hereby certify that on the 29th day of July, 1980, I found evidence of the Section corner of Sections 2 and 3 & Sections 32 & 33 Township 13 North, Range 15 and 16 West, Ohio River Survey, as described hereon; and that from this evidence I established a new monument and accessories as described hereon to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Description of original monument and accessories and subsequent restorations:

Subsequent restorations by Levi Davis, Surveyor Hocking County, in 1868:

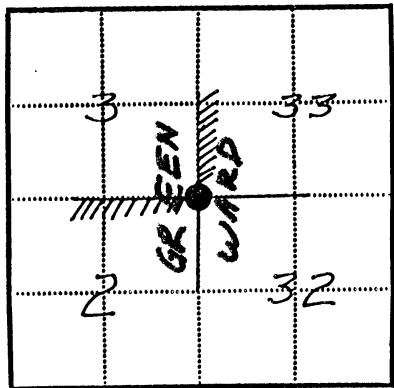
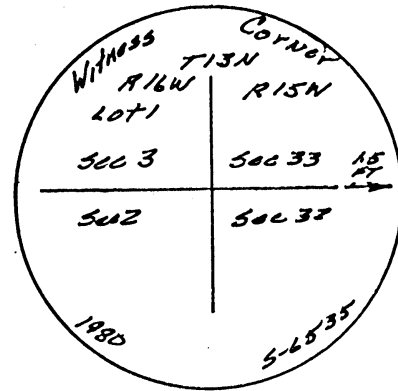
- Bearing trees
W. Oak 14" S51° E 2 Links
W. Oak 12" N44½° W 17 Links

Description of corner evidence found: Found stone with "X" cut in the top. Also found a stump hole two feet southeasterly of the stone, and N 40° W., 11.2 feet (17 Links) from the stone is a white oak tree, 27.2 inches DBH, which is believed to be the original bearing tree called for by Levi Davis in 1868.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set 2"x48" iron pipe filled with concrete with a brass cap set in the top marked as shown. Monument set 1.5 feet west of stone and on Section line. Established the following bearing trees:
White Oak 24" South 8° West 56.3 feet
White Oak 15" South 31° 20' West 39.4 feet
White Oak 12" South 66° 20' West 39.6 feet
