Commencing for reference at a 40" Cherry tree found at the Southwest corner of the Southeast quarter of of Section 18; thence with the South line of Section 18, South 84 degrees 25 minutes 15 seconds East a distance of 425.87 feet, passing a $5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ iron pin found at a distance of 74.07 feet to a $5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ iron pin set and being the point of Beginning of the tract of land to be described;
