

DEED DESCRIPTION

Being a part of the South half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 24, Township 13 North, Range 17 West, Washington Township, Hocking County, Ohio (also being a part of the property of Duane Witzke and Esther Witzke of Deed Book 162, page 165 of the Hocking County Recorder. This is a survey of a tract of land lying South of County Road 303 and also known as Cherry Ridge Road. Said tract is described under land contract between Duane Witzke and Esther Witzke (Mortgagor) to Robert Collins (Mortgagee) described in Mortage Book 150, page 663 of said Hocking County Recorder) and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning, at an iron pipe found, at the Southwest corner of the South half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 24; thence N 5°26' 10" E 269.77 feet, in the mid line of Section 24 and in the East line of the Harold Brimner Etal. property of Deed Book 153, page 742, to an iron pin set, passing an iron pin found at 240.98 feet (said iron pin set bears S 5°26' 10" W 20.21 feet from the existing center-line of County Road 303, also known as Cherry Ridge Road); thence, leaving the mid line of Section 24 and said Brimner property (the following four (4) courses are 20.00 feet South and perpendicular to the center-line of said County Road 303), N 87°06' 05" E 234.78 feet to an iron pin set; thence 481.53 feet on a curve to the right, with a radius of 725.860 feet and with a chord of which bears S 73°53' 48" E 472.75 feet, to an iron pin set; thence S 54° 53' 30" E 134.46 feet to an iron pin set; thence S 50°55' 00" E 261.93 feet to an iron pin set in the South line of Section 24 and in the North line of the Ralph E.
