8) S 53 degrees $46^{\prime} 49^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$ a distance of 66.10 ft . to a point;
9) S 59 degrees $29^{\prime} 24^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$ a distance of 37.89 ft . to a point;
10) S 66 degrees $22^{\prime} 32^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$ a distance of 32.56 ft . to a point;

Thence, leaving Co. Rd. 303 and with west line of the previously cited 3.000 Ac. tract, S 7 degrees $15^{\prime} 32^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$, passing iron pins previously set at 31.01 ft . and 326.01 ft ., going a total distance of 332.65 ft . to the place of beginning, containing 5.8736 acres, more or less, and being subject to the right-of-way of Co. Rd. 303 and all valid easements.

Cited bearings are based on the bearing system of the 3.000 Ac . tract described in O.R. Vol. 532, Pg. 150.
