DELINQUENT SEWER ACCOUNTS: The Commissioners discussed the delinquent sewer accounts. They would like to have a meeting with the Prosecutor, Doug Fisher and Sewer Superintendent Kevin Loudin to discuss the situation and possible options.

FOR THE RECORD: Greg responded to Paul Knoop's Letter to the Editor, saying that existing structures, like barns and silos, can be used for Broadband antennas instead of towers and that will be considered when Broadband comes through the Hocking Hills.

UPDATE ON HAYDENVILLE PARK: Travis Anderson and Rob Bieder from Mara Engineering gave the Commissioners an update on the buried tires where the Haydenville park is to be constructed. They explained that the tires cannot be recycled because the condition they were in, so they were taken to the landfill for disposal. All the tires have been removed, which took three truck loads.

MARJORIE DAVIS-SAFETY COORDINATOR: Safety Coordinator Marjorie Davis spoke to the Commissioners about the Health Fair the county is having for it's employees. She asked the Commissioners if they would allow employees 45 minutes to attend the Health Fair. The Commissioners agreed that they would recommend that each Elected Official or Department Head allow their employees 45 minutes, but is there discretion.
