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**RICK WEBB-TREE COMMISSION:** Rick Webb with the Tree Commission spoke to the Commissioners about the tree proposal and what they would like to do to move forward. Rick said he would like to cut down the one dying tree in front of the courthouse and replace it with a Linden that would be donated by the Democratic Party in memory of Judge Mong. He suggested that maybe they would also plant a thorn less honey locust in the empty spot near the parking lot. John added that they have discussed removing the tree on the other side of the courthouse near the street corner and replace that tree with two or three flagpoles. The Commissioners also told Rick they would be interested in selling the grates around the trees. They decided to proceed to plant a tree where the missing one is near the parking lot and the dying tree will be cut down when the leave fall off. The Commissioners will let Rick know when they are ready to proceed beyond that.

The Commissioners would like to decide what exactly they would like changed in the handbook before they go any further.
