WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP ROAD LIMIT REDUCTION: Motion by Sandy Ogle and seconded by Greg Green to reduce the legal limit on all Washington Township Roads to 50%, effective February 1, 2010 through April 30, 2010. Vote: Ogle, yea, Green, yea, Walker, yea.

PROCLAMATION- TEEN DATING VIOLENCE AWARENESS AND PREVENTION WEEK-FEBRUARY 1-6: Motion by Sandy Ogle and seconded by Greg Green to sign a Proclamation designating the week of February 1-6, 2010 Teen Dating Violence Awareness and Prevention Week. Vote: Ogle, yea, Green, yea, Walker, yea.

AMEND PREVIOUS MOTION: Motion by Greg Green and seconded by Sandy Ogle to amend the previous motion to update the county polity book on page 20, line f, number 4. Vote: Ogle, yea, Green, yea, Walker, yea.

DISCUSSION-HOW FUNDS ARE REIMBURSED TO DEPARTMENTS: The Commissioners discussed departments receiving the funds back that they have paid into the general fund for services such as copies or insurance reimbursement. Currently the funds are paid into the general fund but not re-appropriated back to the department.

JEANNE WILSON- SENATOR SHERROD BROWN'S OFFICE: Jeanne Wilson with Senator Sherrod Brown's Office spoke to the Commissioners about appropriation requests for 2011. She said that the average award is \$750,000 and they are looking for direct job creation. John mentioned the sewer study they wanted to do last year. Jeanne said this will not fund a study, but will look into some possibilities for that. She spoke to the Commissioners about the new biodiesel/wastewater facility to be constructed in Harrison County.
