JEAN MAGDICH AND ROBERT LYTLE: Jean Magdich and Robert Lytle spoke to the Commissioners about their concerns about the ATV park that is going to be opening near their property. Jean explained that she lived on her property for 28 years and has created art gardens. The noise levels concern her as well as traffic and her property value. She does not feel that the ATV park promotes Hocking County. They asked the Commissioners if there was anything they could do and said they feel like a decision has already been made with the Kilbarger case several years ago. The Commissioners explained that this was a civil matter and they should speak with the Prosecutor and their trustees.

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continued to explain the remaining jury trials scheduled for the year. The judge requested the Commissioners allocated him \$6,000 more in juror fees to cover the year.

SAFETY COORDINATOR MARJORIE DAVIS: Safety Coordinator Marjorie Davis spoke to the Commissioners about where she can hang the poster for the courthouse. The Commissioners suggested hanging it on the wall by the parking lot doors. She also asked them what kind of plan is in place for Level 3 Snow Emergency, as she is preparing for the emergency training next week. They explained to her the Sheriff will do a reverse 911 to the department heads in a level 3 emergency. She mentioned to the Commissioners that there are some elected officials and department heads who have not had NIMS training. The Commissioners instructed Marjorie to check with EMA Director Susan Rauber as to who needs to have the training and if necessary, to schedule a training session.

<u>LAKE MOOR SEWER DISCUSSION:</u> The Commissioners discussed an issue at Lake Moor in which a property owner does not want to hook onto the sewer system. He said the Health Department said he could put in a septic system. The Commissioners think there is something in the policy book or the ORC requiring anyone within a certain distance of the sewer to hook on. Sandy said she will speak with Wendy at the Health Department and Sewer Engineering Consultant Fred Klinglehafer.

LETTER FROM OHIO DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE: The Commissioners received a letter from the Ohio Department of Agriculture responding to the Commissioners request to have a meeting for the affected residents in Hocking County for the spray for gypsy moth. The letter explained they do not have the man power to have another meeting, but would be willing to do a mailing. The Commissioners will send a letter to the Department of Agriculture to tell them they would like them to do a mailing.
