AUDITOR KEN WILSON: Auditor Ken Wilson gave the Commissioners an update on Broadband, saying that now the state is instructing them to proceed county by county instead of a group. He continued to explain some of the goals of the Broadband Committee and informed the Commissioners that they will be asking for their approval of and RFP for an internet service provider. Ken also spoke to the Commissioners about Recovery Zone Bonds, explaining that the money that was not claimed by various counties and municipalities is now available for reallocation and said that if they were interested in applying for more money they would have to have the paperwork in by April 1st.

BILL ACTION: Motion by Sandy Ogle and seconded by Greg Green to approve the county bills and Then & Now purchase orders dated March 26, 2010 totaling \$94,274.57. Vote: Ogle, yea, Green, yea.

SYSTEMS ADMINISTRATOR SHAUN LEHMAN: Systems Administrator Shaun Lehman spoke to the Commissioners about possibilities for internet service for the courthouse. Currently the courthouse is served by Hocking Internet Technologies, but Shaun requested a quote from Time Warner Cable, which was half of the cost with more bandwidth. Greg said he would prefer to stay with a local provider, but they are spending public dollars and need to be responsible. Sandy agreed with Greg's statement and they asked Shaun to call Hocking Internet to see if they could counter the quote from Time Warner and to inform him the county will be paying monthly until a decision is made.

TRAVEL: Motion by Sandy Ogle and seconded by Greg Green to approve the following requests for travel:

CONTINUITY OF GOVERNMENT: Motion by Sandy Ogle and seconded by Greg Green to designate, under Continuity of Government, Common Pleas Court to have authority in the courthouse during an emergency or disaster if the Commissioners were not available, with Juvenile/Probate Court second, and Municipal Court third. Vote: Ogle, yea, Green, yea.
