RITTGERS ROAD DECISION: Motion by John Walker and seconded by Sandy Ogle not to vacate Rittgers Road, T-99, Marion Township, as petitioned. Vote: Walker, yea, Ogle, yea, Green, yea.

DISCUSSION: Sandy noted that they made their decision because the adjacent property owners do not want the road closed.
