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<u>BILL ACTION:</u> Motion by Sandy Ogle and seconded by John Walker to approve the county bills and Then & Now purchase orders dated September 10, 2010 totaling \$53,672.09 and the EMS bills dated August 16-31, 2010. SEWER DISCUSSION: The Commissioners discussed the Sewer Contract Services line item being low again and approximated that they will need around \$19,500 for the remainder of the year to cover needed repairs. They will further discuss the issue on Tuesday.

BROADBAND UPDATE: Greg gave an update on the Broadband RFP review. He suggested that the county share in the cost of the rental of the MARCS towers for the first few years, and is looking at grant funds to do this.
