COMMISSIONERS MEETING DECEMBER 21, 2010

The Board of Hocking County Commissioners met in regular session this 21st day of December 2010 with the following members present John Walker, Sandy Ogle, and Greg Green.

MEETING: The meeting was called to order by President Greg Green.

MINUTES: Motion by Sandy Ogle and seconded by John Walker to accept the minutes. Vote: Walker, yea, Ogle, yea, Green, yea.

AGENDA: Motion by John Walker seconded by Sandy Ogle to approve the agenda. Vote: Walker, yea, Ogle, yea, Green, yea.

HAPCAP-GREG ANDREWS: Greg Andrews from HAPCAP spoke to the Commissioners giving an update on the CHIP program; it is time to start the new application process and asked the Commissioners if they wanted HAPCAP to proceed with the application process. The Commissioners all agreed that they would.

SEWER PROJECT OWDA – WASHINGTON STREET: John spoke about the project on Washington Street and that it may be eligible for funds through the EPA for the project. He said he attended an OWDA meeting that explained the program. John stated that other communities will possibly be eligible for funding at a later date and needed added to the possible project list so the EPA will be aware of possible future projects.

APPROVE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FOR WASHINGTON STREET SEWER PROJECT: Motion by Sandy Ogle and seconded by John Walker to submit an application for funding through EPA for Washington St. to RCAP - Rural Community Assistance Program by January 4, 2011.

Diane stated that \$6068.24 would not be enough to cover expenses but is willing to work with the commissioners and will take \$7500.00.

TREASURER -SEWER BILL COMPENSATION: Motion by Sandy Ogle seconded by John Walker to approve Auditor Ken Wilson to set up a new line item for \$7,500.00 in the Sewer Budget, for the Treasure to operate the sewer billing for one year.
