#### **BEN FICKEL:**

Hocking County Prosecutor Ben Fickel presented a resolution for the building on State Route 595 to give Hocking County Board of Developmental Disabilities authority to sublease the building. Commissioner Ogle read the following resolution:

Whereas: Effective July 1, 2017, Hocking Valley Industries, Inc (HVI) will operate as a private entity, separate for the Hocking County Board of Developmental Disabilities (HCBDD); and

Whereas: In order to facilitate the continuation of services for people with developmental disabilities in Hocking County; and

Whereas: The facility currently located at 1566. SR 595, Logan, Ohio is currently owned by the Hocking County Commissioners, purchase by the HCBDD, and is operated / maintained by funding provided through the HCBDD; and

Be It Resolved that: The HCBDD shall be permitted to use the facility to support the services to people with developmental disabilities;

The HCBDD may lease part/sublease parts of the facilities to providers of services, as deemed appropriate by the HCBDD; and

Should the facility no longer be needed for support such services, the facility shall revert back to the Commissioners for their use.

Motion by Gary Waugh and seconded by Jeff Dickerson.

Prosecutor Fickel gave an update that the Prosecutor's Office received a grant from the Department of Justice for another attorney and support staff. Prosecutor Fickel said Gretchen is looking into something for the fairgrounds and she also found grants for the Humane Society.

Prosecutor Fickel commented when he talked to Mr. Stewart, Pickaway County received no grant money for their grandstand. They received an OWA grant which was a \$50,000.00 match grant. The rest was donations and private funding for the 13 million dollar fairgrounds.

Prosecutor Fickel discussed the Union Furnace Sewer Project and four properties still holding out on easements. Mr. Fickel said in order to do eminent domain they must make an offer first then file a

lawsuit. Prosecutor Fickel asked what the amount would be that the commissioners are willing to pay. Commissioner Waugh said they would have to talk to Mr. Silcott first. Motion by Jeff Dickerson and seconded by Gary Waugh to give the Prosecutor permission to talk to Mr. Silcott to establish value of the remaining easements.
