Commissioner Ogle asked about the number of visitors, and Blair responded that the majority of the visitors are all kids, camp wanakita. The grant will help with the trail and parking lot, which will increase foot traffic.

Andy Maytak

Andy Maytak stated to the Board that a quarter of a mile that was recorded on the presentation Engineer Doug Dillon presented, was on a private drive. Maytak said that they are seeking for the video to be stopped, it is not factual, and for Dillon to issue an apology. Maytak stated that the video is harming their reputation.
