Gary Silcott provided updates on the following sewer projects: Murray City, Enterprise, Hocking Valley Scenic Trails, West Street, Rockbridge Sewer Updates Phase 1, Haydenville Sewer Updates Phase 2, and Demolition Grant.

Commissioner Ogle and Mr. Silcott exchanged conversation about Murray City and Hocking Valley Scenic Trail, and the amount that is being sought for the HVST, Gary Silcott and Tracy Shoults answered 5.5M.

Tracy Shoults presented a request to transfer money from the Murray City contingencies to contracts, so that money can be applied to the settlement with Xpress, an amount of \$75,000.00. Tracy clarified that DLZ never makes payments on behalf of the board, that will be done by the board. The request only transfers the money

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from one category to another. Tracy Shoults also presents a request for signature so she may be able to apply the signature to an online signature, for the application of the HVST. Commissioner Ogle expressed concern and requested more information before she signed. Tracy left paperwork for the clerk, to finish up some loose ends.
