Lake Logan Restoration Plan

Carol Mackey And Stuart Bruney presented an update on the Lake Logan Restoration Project to fix the dam, mitigate vegetation, and dredge the lake working with the ODNR. There was discussion on 3 hopeful sites of where to put the dredge material. They have been meeting with Senator Wilkin, planning on holding another community meeting, talking with stakeholders, HHTA,(who funded the study of the Lake) Logan City Council, The Commissioners, Health Department, Hocking County Fish and Game, Hocking County Soil and Water Conservation District, Chamber of Commerce, Hocking Hills Lodging Owners Association, Falls township Trustees, Friends of the Hocking Hills State Parks, and Friends for the Preservation of Ohio State Parks.

There are 8-10 recommendations that might be implemented at the lake but the Lake Logan Associations top 3 are to with spot treatments of 12 acres of Milfoil, mechanical harvesting of 16.7 acres of lotus-leaving a 20 foot buffer around the shoreline, and dredging, including 21.4 acres of Clearfork and Duck Creek Fingers.
