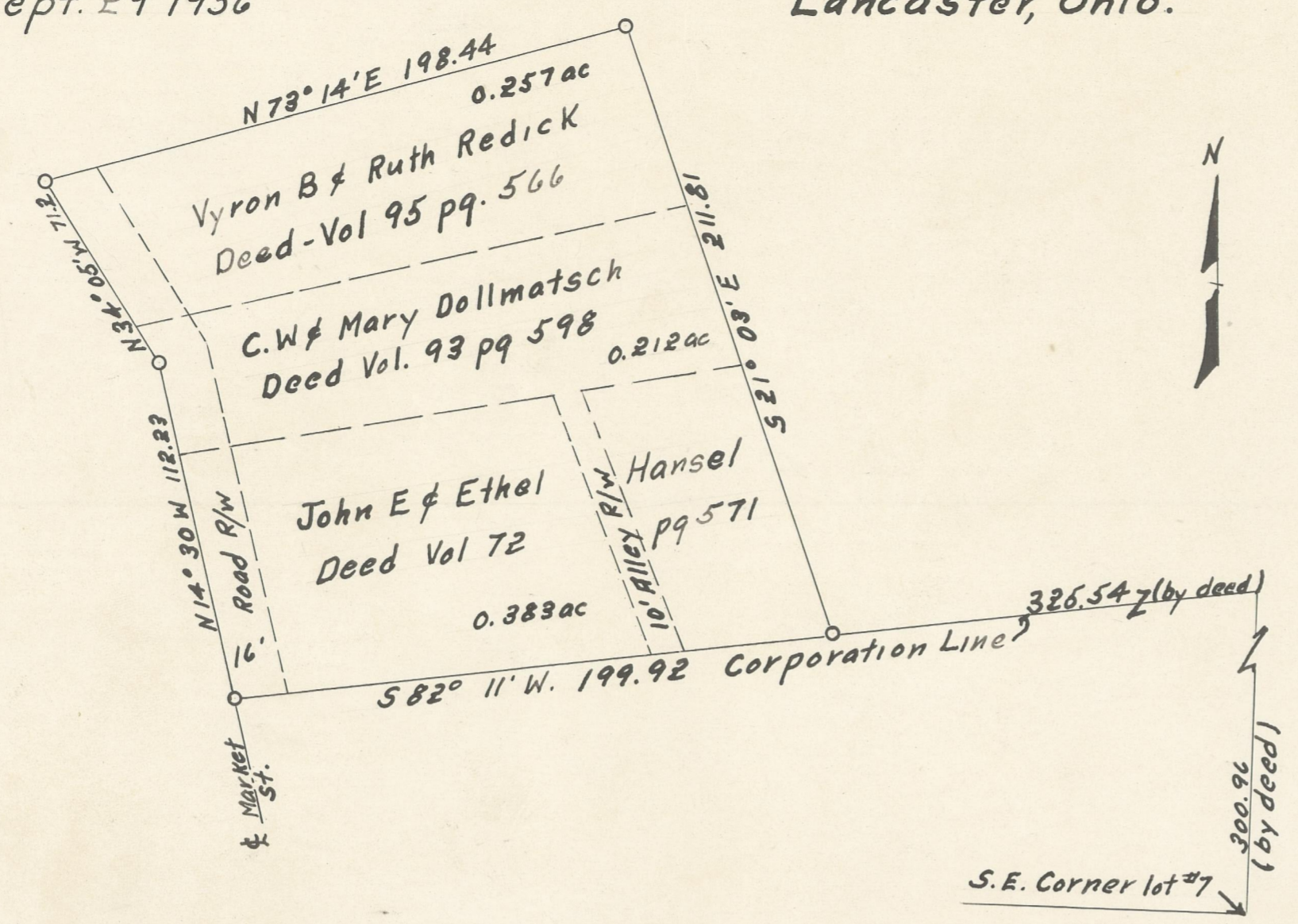


**PLAT OF TERRITORY.

E. Corner of said fractional lot No. 7; thence S 82° 11' W 199.92 ft. to an iron spike in the center line of Market St.; thence with the center line of Market St. extended N 14° 30' W. 112.23 ft. to an iron pin; thence N 34° 05' W 71.2 ft. to an iron pin; thence N 73° 14' E 198.44 ft. to an iron pin; thence S 21° 03' E 211.81 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 0.852 acre, and being a part of Logan City School District.

ORDER OF COMMISSIONERS FOR ANNEXATION

The Commissioners of the County of Hocking, State of Ohio, proceeding this day to hear the petition of John E. Hansel and others to obtain the annexation of the territory in their petition described to the City of Logan, and having in open meeting heard all the persons desiring to be heard for or against the granting of said petition and considered the affidavits presented with reference thereto, and being fully advised find that said petition contains all the matters required by law, that its statements are true, that the territory sought to be annexed is adjacent to the said City of Logan; that the petition contains a full description of said territory; that the map of said territory attached to the petition is accurate; that said petition is signed by a majority of the adult freeholders residing on the territory sought to be annexed; that the required legal notice of the petition has been given, and that it is right and proper that said petition should be granted.

It is hereby ordered that the prayer of said petition be granted, and that the territory described in said petition may be annexed to the City of Logan in accordance with law, and that a certified transcript signed by a

ORDINANCE NO. 5
1957

ACCEPTING APPLICATION FOR ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOGAN, STATE OF OHIO: --

Section 1. That the application of John E. Hansel and others for the annexation of the following described territory in the County of Hocking and adjacent to the City of Logan, to-wit: Situate in the Township of Falls, in the County of Hocking and State of Ohio, and bound and described as follows: Being a part of Fraction lot No. 7, in Section No. 11 T14 W17 Hocking, County, Ohio, beginning at an iron pin 300.96 ft. north and thence S 82° 11' W. 325.54 ft. by deed call from the S.E. Corner of said fractional lot No. 7; thence S 52° 11' W. 199.92 ft. to an iron spike in the center line of Market St.; thence with the center line of Market St. extended E 14° 30' N. 112.23 ft. to an iron pin; thence E 34° 05' W. 71.2 ft. to an iron pin; thence N 73° 14' E. 198.44 ft. to an iron pin; thence S 21° 03' N. 211.81 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 0.852 acre, and being a part of Logan City School District.

An accurate map of which territory, together with the petition for its annexation, and other papers relating thereto, and a certified transcript of the proceedings of the County Commissioners in relation thereto, are on file with the Clerk of the Council of said city, be and the same is hereby accepted.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
