

ORDINANCE NUMBER 44
Accepting application for annexation of territory.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Logan,
Hocking County, Ohio: Section One:— That the
application of Charles Bell, et al, for the annex-
ation of the following described territory in the County
of Hocking, State of Ohio, and adjacent to the City of Logan.

FIRST TRACT: Beginning at an iron pin 194 feet in a
Westerly direction from the corporation line along the North
line of Hunter Street; thence 77°-50' right at a bearing of North
3°-30' East (the same being the East boundary line of sec.
11) 1642.4 ft.; thence East 233.7 feet; thence South
with a bearing of South 6°-0' West with the corporation
line to the North boundary line of Hunter St. to an
iron pin; thence with the aforesaid mentioned line
of Hunter St. 194 feet to the place
of beginning, the same being known as the
Spring Dale Addition, A. H. Riff having caused the
same to be laid out as such and platted Oct. 28,
1912.

SECOND TRACT: Beginning at an iron pipe on sec.
line between Sec's 10 & 11, Twp. 14, R 17, Falls Twp.
Hocking County, Ohio, said iron pipe being 2775.2
feet South of the North East corner of Sec. 10, and
being the South West corner of Spring Dale Addition
to Logan, Ohio, and the South-East corner of Bell &
Scholl Addition; thence along Hunter St. N 73°-53'
West 824.2 feet to an iron pin, being the South West
corner of Addition; thence along County Road North
8°-30' East 251.4 feet to an iron pin, being the corner
of Church St.; thence North 27°-45' East 802.1 feet to an
iron pin, being the North West corner of Addition; thence
South 73°-53' East 488.7 feet to the North East corner of
Addition, same being on Sec. line between Sec 10 & 11,
Twp. 14, R 17, 2717.6 feet South of North East corner of
Sec. 10; thence South 4°-45' West 1057.6 feet along
Sec. line to the place of beginning, containing 16.37
acres, more or less.

And accurate maps of which territory, together
with the Petition for its annexation, and other papers
relating thereto, and a certified transcript of the proceed-
ings of the County Commissioners in relation thereto
are on file with the clerk of the Council of said
City of Logan, be, and the same is hereby accepted.
Section two:— This ordinance shall take effect
and be in force and effect from and after the earliest
period allowed by Law.

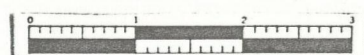
