I hereby certify the foregoing to be a correct Plat of S. Churchill, J. Little, and A. Bishop's addition to the town of Logan in Hocking County Ohio. — Being a part of fractional lot No. 3 in sections 11, 12, 13, 14, Range No. 17, Reference being had to Record of Plats of Fractions at Lots in Hocking County Ohio, estimated to contain 16 65/100 Acres from the center of Hocking Canal to the North line of the residue.
The Regular lots are 200 by 81 1/4 links and contain 16 1/4 hundredths of an acre. The length, breadth and quantity of each fractional lot is written on it and numbered as follows, 467, 468, 469, 472, 473, 474, 475, 476, 477, 478, 479, 480, 481, 482, 483, 484, 485, 486, 487, 488, 489, 490, 491, 492, 493, 494, 495, 496, 497, 498, 499, 500, 501, 502, 503, 504, 505, 506, 507, 508, 509. Iron and Elm streets are each 81 1/4 links wide and run North and South, Church Street is 75 links wide and Third Street is 61 linkswide and they run east and west. The alleys are 25 links wide except the alley between lots 484, 485, 486 and 487, which is 18 links wide. Hunter and West Streets are as indicated on the plat.
