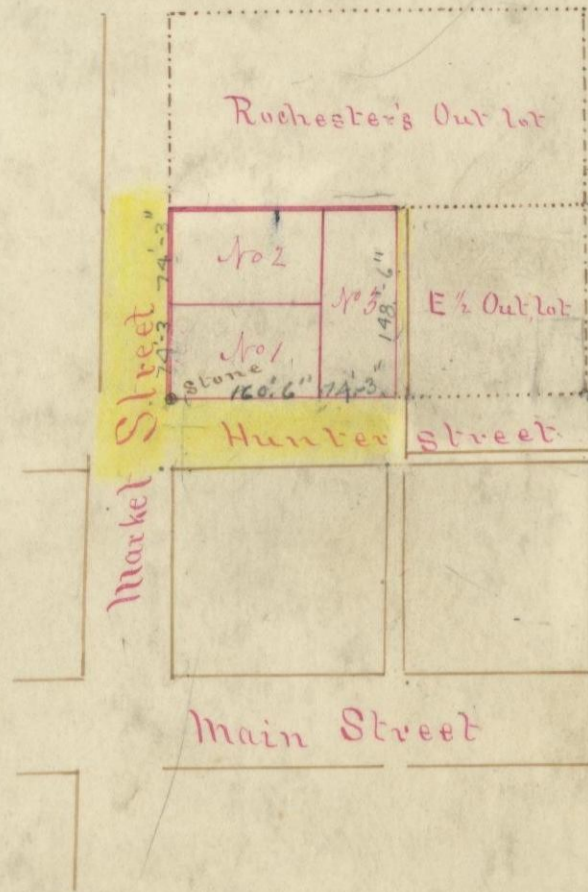


Plat of Frazer's Addition to the town of Logan.

The above is a plat of a division of the west half of Out lot No two as designated on the Original plat of the town of Logan in Hocking County Ohio, commencing at a stone 25 poles North and one pole west (with the variation) of a stone on N.E. corner of Market and Main Streets; Lots No 1 and 2 being 74 ft 3 in fronting Market Street and at right angles back 160 ft 6 in, Lot No 3 being 74 feet 3 in fronting Hunter Street and at right angles back 148 ft 6 in, Hunter Street 66 feet in width, the alley between Market and Mulberry 8 ft 3 in. June 15, 1839
