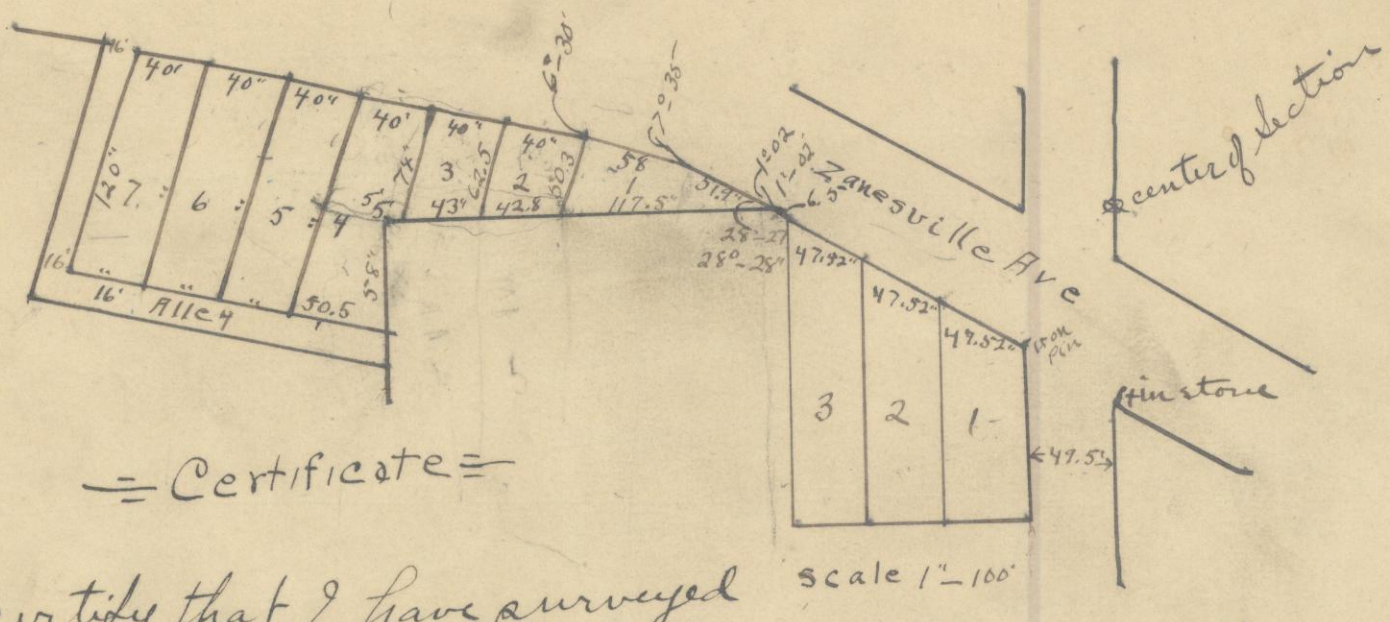

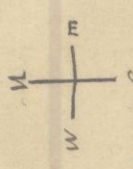

I hereby certify that I have surveyed the land in the attached Plat. it is located in Hocking County, State of Ohio Township 14, Range 17, Section 12, bounded & described as follows:

Starting at the Northeast corner of Lot Number 3 of the Lavina Wright Addition; thence along the west line of Zanesville Avenue 6.5 ft; thence with an angle of 120° to the left 51.9 ft, to a stake thence with an angle of 72° 35' to the left 5.8 ft. to a stake; thence with an angle of 6° 30' to the left 256 ft. to the line fence thence with an angle of 83° 35' to the left 136 ft. to a stake thence in a Southwesterly direction paralleling Zanesville Avenue 187.5 ft. to line fence; thence East 74 ft. to N.E. corner of Lavina Wright Addition thence South 208.3 ft. to the place of beginning containing (7) Lots.
