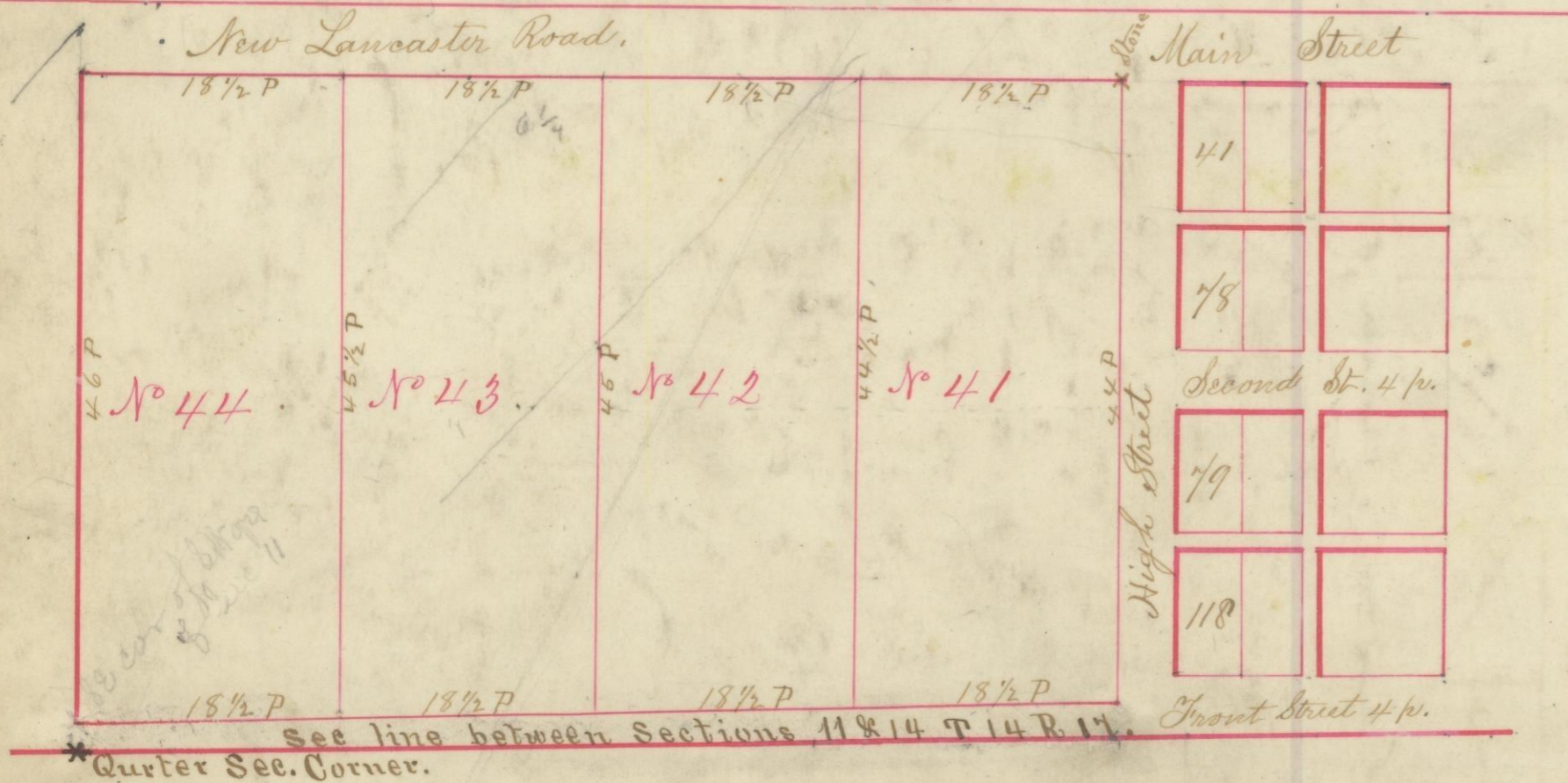


Plat of Additional Out Lots to the Town of Logan.

Description of Lots

The Out Lots Nos 41, 42, 43 and 44 of the Town of Logan all front on the New Lancaster Road, which is a continuation of Main Street and extends back to the South boundary of Sec 11 Sp. 14 R 17. The dimensions of each lot is marked upon its boundaries, as are also its courses. The southwest corner of Out Lot No 44 is also the south west corner of the south east quarters of section No 11 aforesaid. A stone is placed at the North east corner of Out Lot No 41, which is at the intersection of Main Street with High Street. — I do hereby certify that the above plat and accompanying description are correct. Given under my hands at Logan this 6th day of December 1833
