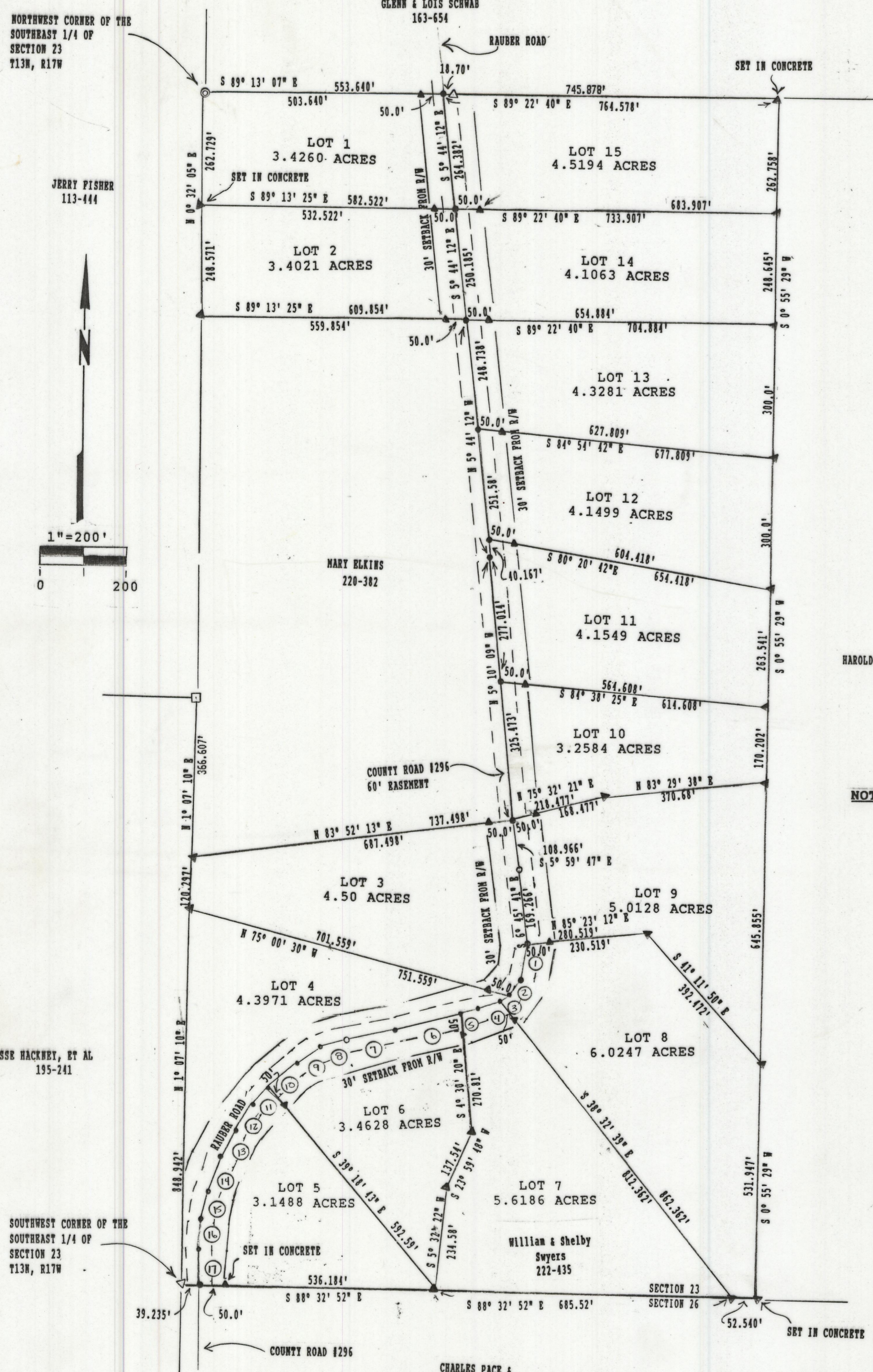

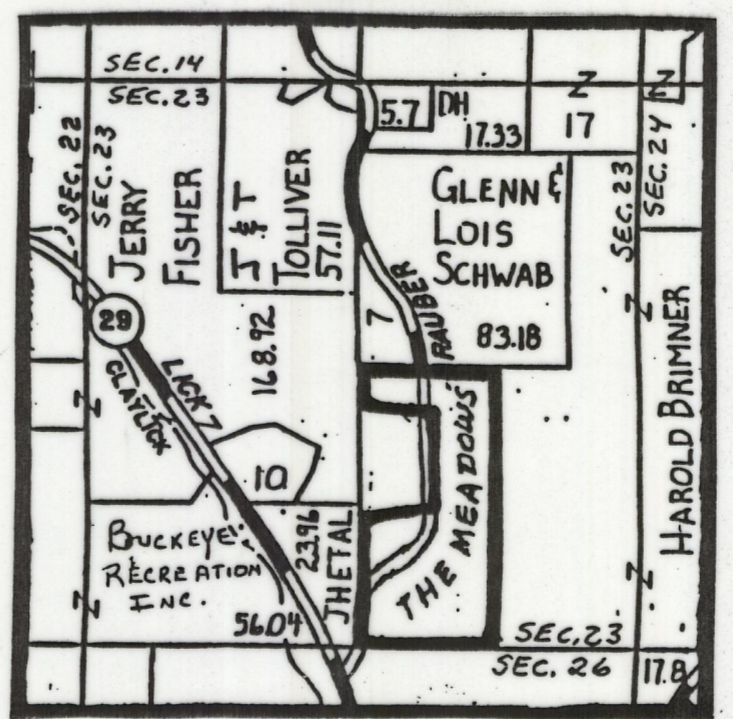

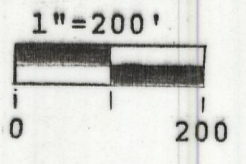


Location Map 1"=2000'
