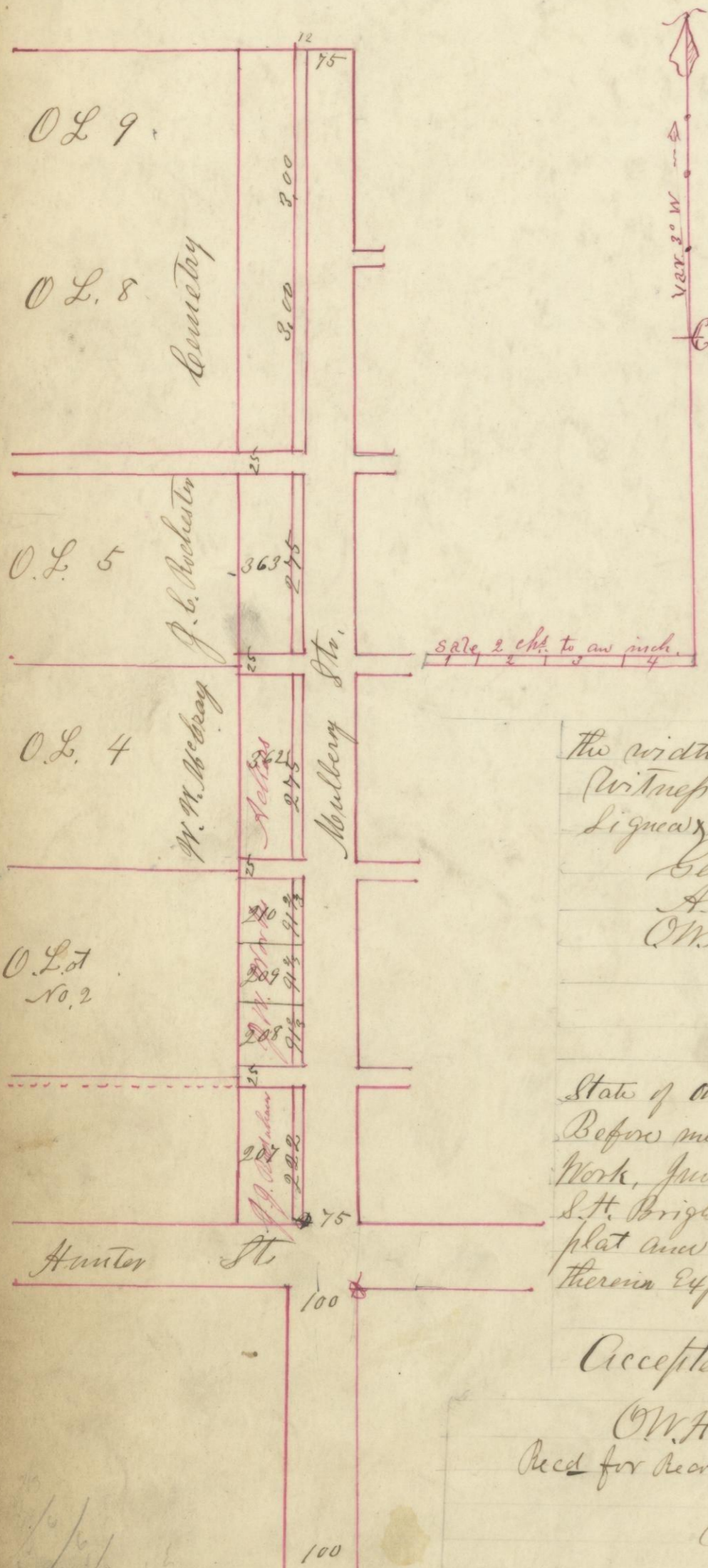


Plat of an Extension of width of North Mulberry Street Logan Ohio.



I hereby certify that the foregoing is correct plat of a survey of an addition, to the width of that part of Mulberry street lying N. of Hunter Street in the Village of Logan Hocking County O. Beginning at a Stake from which the S.E. corner of Lot No. 207 of said Village bears N 89 1/2° E 12 links, thence N 50° W across (lots 207, 208, 209, 210, 362 and 363, and out Lots Nos 8 and 9 and intervening alleys 17, 22 chains to the N line of out Lot No 9. thence East 12 links, thence S. 0° 30' E along the west line of said Mulberry Street 17, 22 chains to the South East corner of said inlet No 207 thence 12 links to beginning, containing .20 of an acre of which amount, .027 is off of Lot 207, .033 off of lots 208, 209 & 210, .033 is off of lot 362, .033 is off of lot 363, and .032 is off of out Lots 8 & 9. Be it remembered, that we the undersigned, proprietors of the lands described in and by the foregoing plat do hereby dedicate and donate to the Village of Logan the said strip of land 12 links wide and running North and South along the west side of Mulberry Street in said Village or so much thereof as is owned by us respectively the same to be occupied by said Village for the purpose of increasing the width of said Mulberry Street and for no other use or purpose whatsoever.
