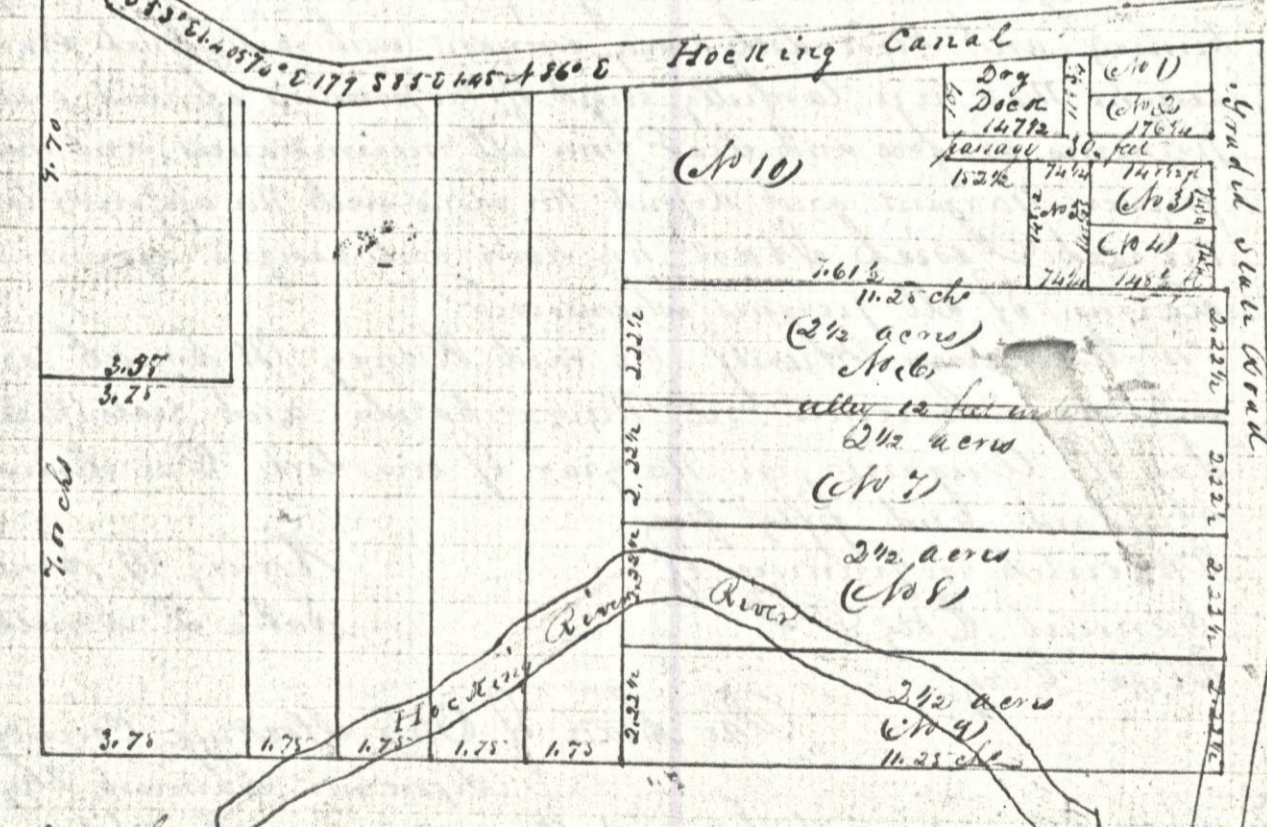

Cline his heirs and assigns forever the following premises situated in the County of Wooster in the State of Ohio and bounded and described as follows to wit: So much of Section Number Seven and Township Number Seven Range Number Seven as is embraced in the following lots numbered & shown on map of five & six square being had to the annexed plat said Cline to dig or cause to be dug a ditch across lot Number six so as to drain the water off of the lots lying south or what may pass through the Dry Rock said Cline to give six feet off of the south side of lot Number six & said Bishop to give six feet off of the north side of lot Number seven for the purpose of a passage from the Public road on the east

To have and to hold said premises with the appurtenances unto the said Daniel S. Cline his heirs and assigns forever and the said Gilbert Bishop for himself and heirs doth hereby covenant with said Daniel S. Cline his heirs and assigns that he is lawfully seized of
