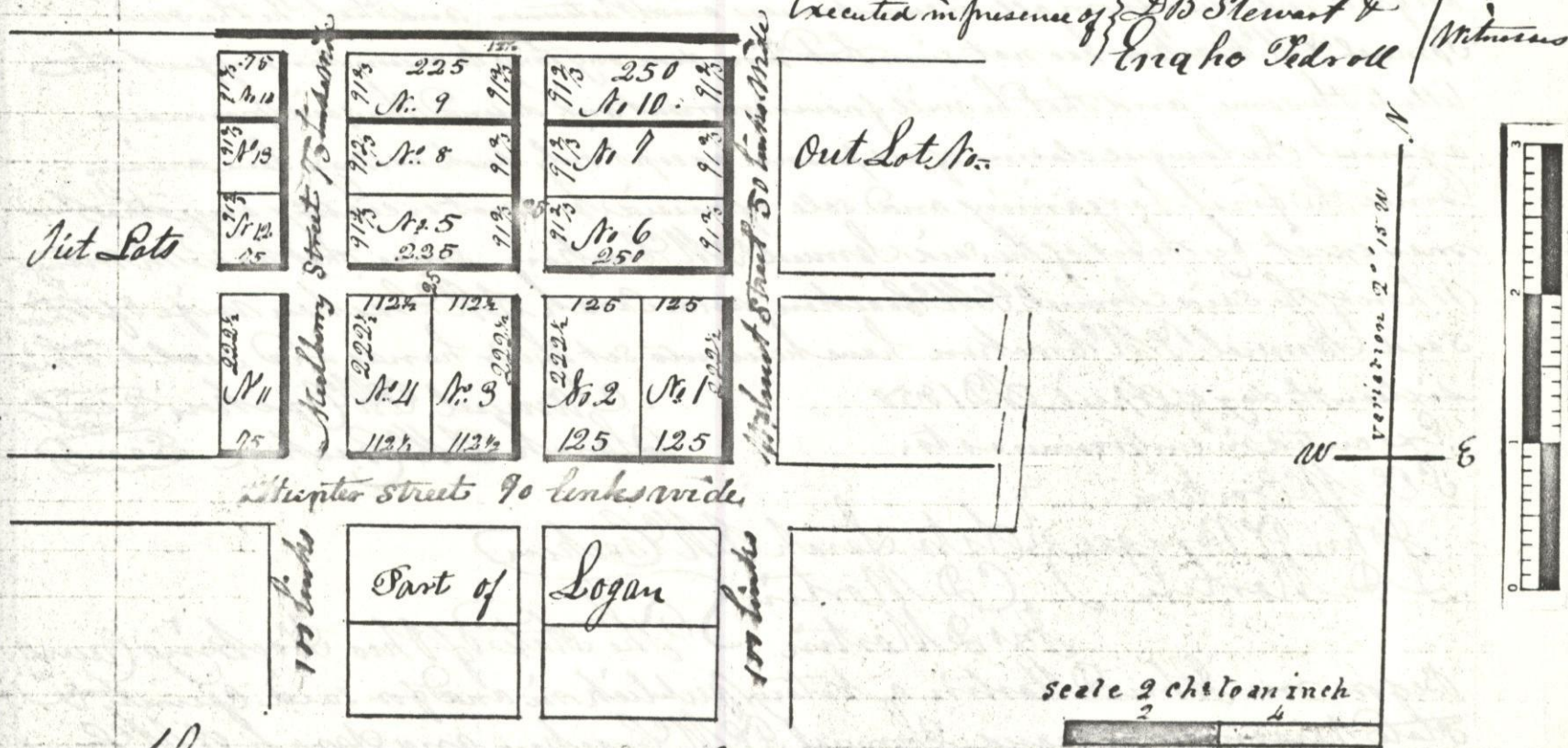

I hereby certify that I subdivided Out Lot No. 11 as designated by the foregoing plat from Lot No. 1 to 11 inclusive as an addition to the Town of Logan with the length and breadth of each lot written in links upon the plat. Walnut Street is 50 links wide and runs North & South Mulberry Street is 75 links wide and is parallel to Walnut. Hunter Street is 90 links wide and at right angles with Walnut and Mulberry the alley on the North side is 12 links wide the other 25 done at the instance of Case & Summers.
