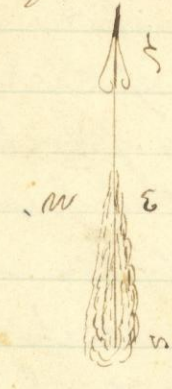


Plat of Additional out Lots to the Town of Logan laid out by Tho Worthington

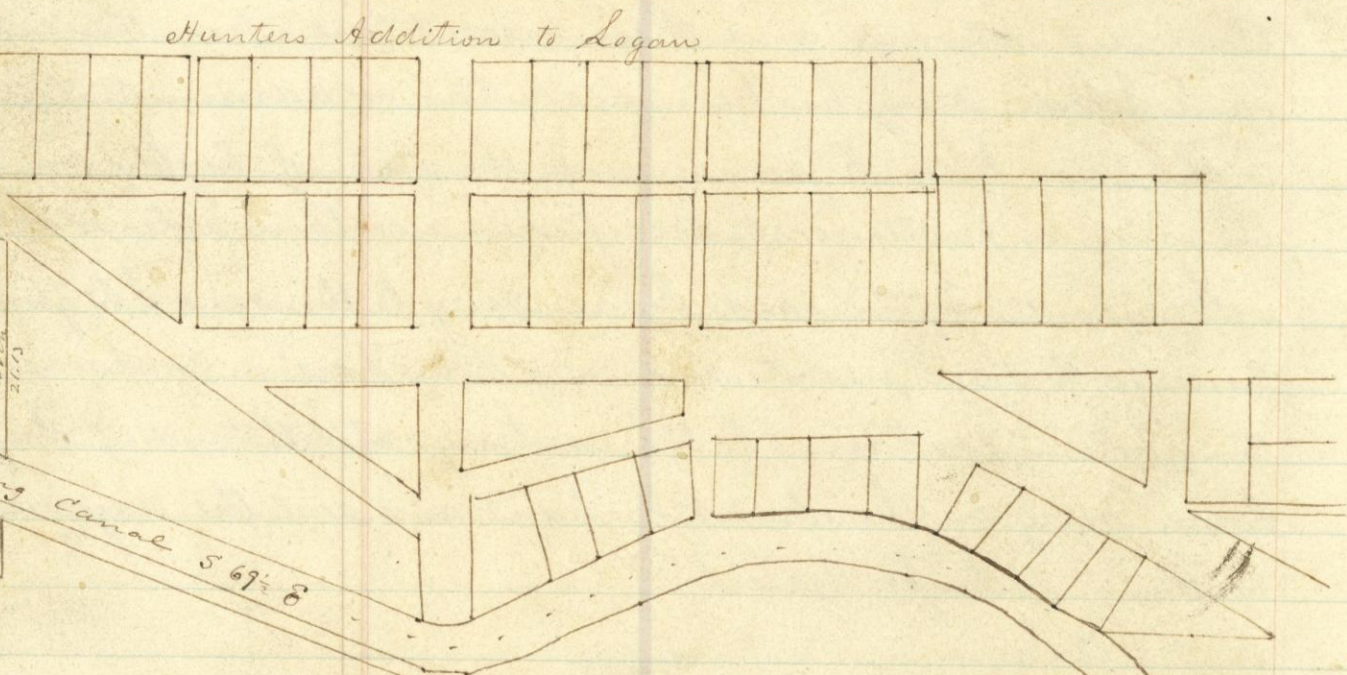
