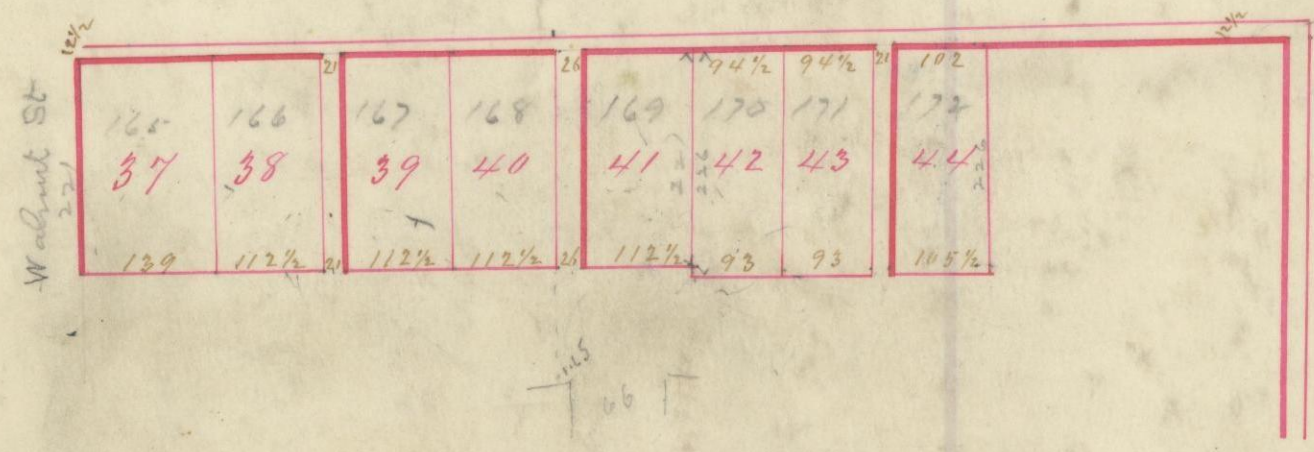


Hunsicker and Adams' addition to the Town of Logan.

I do hereby certify the within to be a true survey of the within named lots with the length of each line as returned to me by David Engle ——— Byers chainmen, the North alley 12 1/2 links the alley west of Lot No 39 twentyone links, the alley west of Lot No 41 twenty six links, the north the corners not set by me, the street 91 links, see the original plat corners at which stones are set as follows N — NE

Hoeking County surveyor office July 21 AD 1838, the within with streets and alleys was laid out by James C. Neill.
