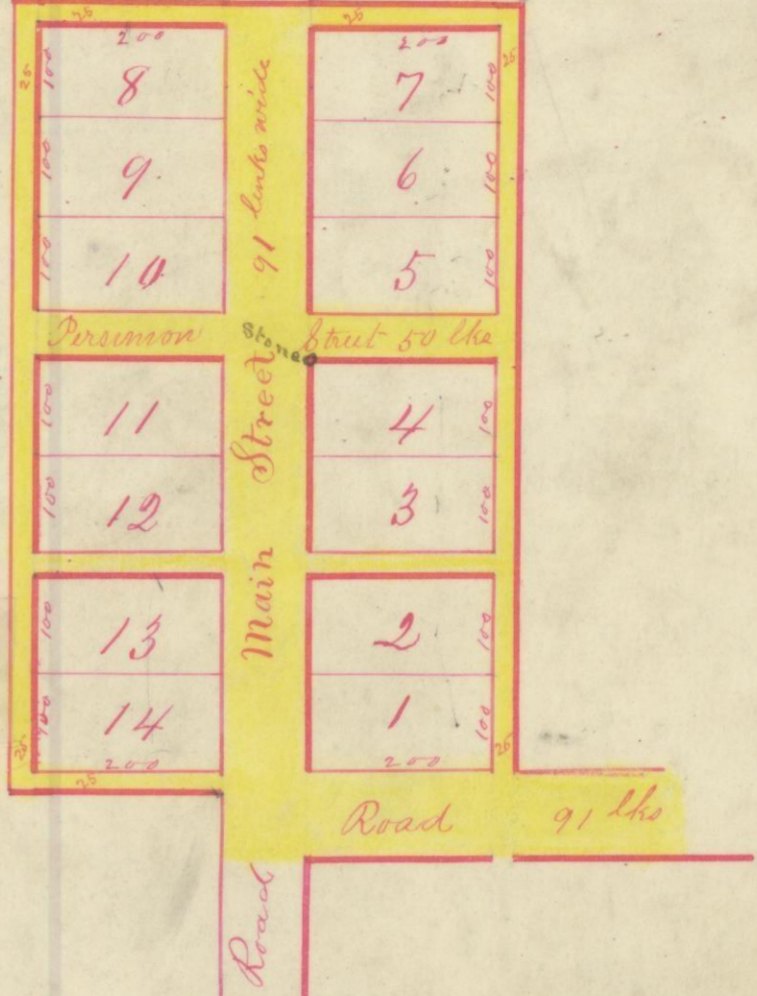


Plat of the Town of Maysville.

I hereby certify that I laid out, for James Price, Robert Baird and Zachariah Linton, the town of Maysville, situate in the south east corner of the SE quarter of and the south west corner of the SE quarter of Section No. 18, Tp. N. 13 R. E. 16 Ohio Company purchase Hocking County Ohio, all the lots from No. 1 to No. 14 inclusive. The lots are all 100 links wide and 200 links long and contain 1/2 of an acre. Main Street is 91 l. wide and runs North-South. Persimmon Street is 50 l. wide and runs East and West. The alleys are each 25 l. wide. The south end of the town west of Main Street runs to the section line. The North end west of Main Street runs to the quarter line on the east and north, so as to include the road. A stone planted at the North west corner of Lot No. 4. Surveyed April 28, 1852 by Geo Davis Surveyor H. C. O.

State of Ohio Hocking County Sd. Before me an acting Justice of the Peace personally appeared James Price, Robert Baird and Zachariah Linton of the county of Hocking and State aforesaid and acknowledged the foregoing plat of the town of Maysville to be their voluntary act and deed for all purposes therein contained. Given under my hand this 30 day of May A.D. 1852 Attest Wm. M. Price J. P.
