I hereby certify the foregoing to be a correct plat of L. A. Culver's addition to the town of Logan Hocking County Ohio, being Outlots 5 and 12 and the west ends of Lots Nos 289 in said town. Said addition embraced 19 lots and are numbered from 356 to 374 inclusive. The Lots are 225 by 92 links and contain 24 hundredths of an acre, Except fractional Lots 362, 363, 367 & 368 which are 276 by 86 links and contain 24 hundredths of an acre. Mulberry and Walnut Streets are each 75 links wide and run north and south. The alleys are each 25 links wide, except the alley north of lot No 360 and the alley ^{on the} north side of said addition which are only 12 1/2 links wide the alleys run at right angles and parallel to the streets.
