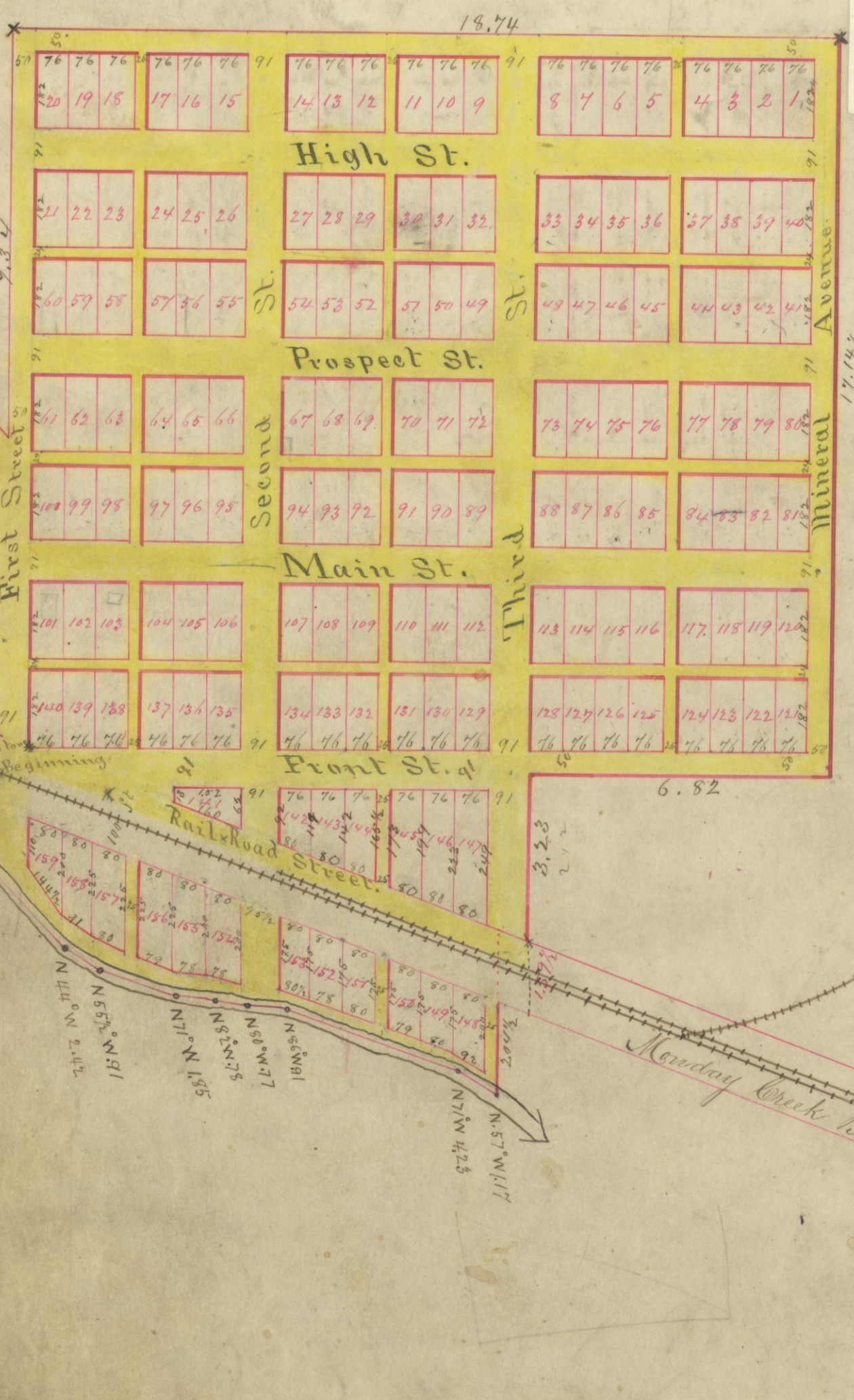


67 Map of Carbonhill Hocking Co. O.

I hereby certify the foregoing to be a correct plat of Carbonhill in Ward Township, Hocking County Ohio, Beginning at the S.E. corner of Fractional Lot No. 1, in Section 27, Township 13 Range 15, Ohio Company's purchase, thence N. 3 Chains, thence E. 20 links, thence N. 14.142 chs. to a post thence E. 15.74 chs. to a post, thence S. 17.14 chs. to a post, in the south line of said section, thence west 5.82 chains to a post, thence S. through section 26 to the S.E. corner of Lot No. 159, thence S. to a post, thence N. 57.117 chs. thence N. 71.142 chs. thence N. 85.191 chs. thence N. 80.177 chs. thence N. 52.178 chs. N. 71.142 chs. N. 65.191 chs. N. 42.142 chs. to a post in Monday Creek, thence N. 2.14 chs. to beginning, containing 33.59 acres, 32.24 acres of which is in section 27 and 1.35 acres in section 26. Said town contains 159 lots, numbering from 1 to 159 inclusive. The regular lots are 76 links front, and extend back 152 links and contain $\frac{1}{10}$ of an acre, the dimensions of all fractional lots are written on them respectively, also the width of the streets and alleys are written in links on the plat. Dedication: Be it known that we I. Finley, P. Crighton and Lydia Fuller, proprietors of the town of Carbonhill, have laid out all the Lots from 1 to 159 inclusive and caused as stones of proper size to be placed at the S.W. corner of Lot No. 1, and we do set apart and dedicate to public use all the Streets, Alleys and Avenues, designated by the plat and survey of said town. Given under our hands this 17 day of April 1873.
