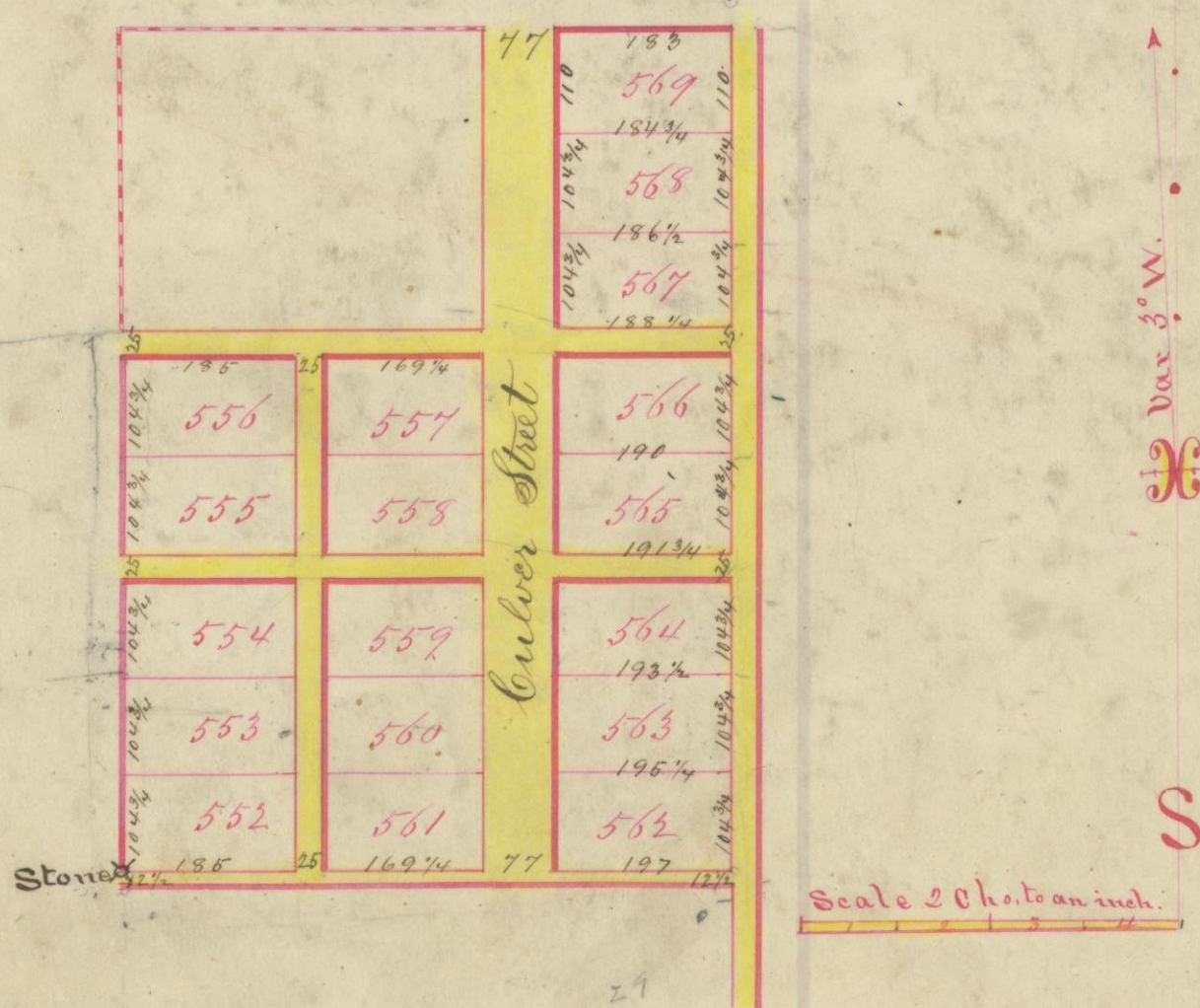

Beginning at the southwest corner of out Lot No. 28 thence east 6.53 1/4 chs, thence North 9.05 1/4 chs, thence west 2.44 1/4 chs, thence south 3.19 1/4 chs, thence west 3.95 chs, thence south 5.86 1/4 chs to beginning, containing 4.58 acres, the said tract contains 18 lots as designated by the plat, the length and breadth are written on them respectively and all other distances and width of streets and alleys, are written in links on the plat and a stone is planted at the southwest corner of Lot No. 552.
