

Smart and Ankeny's Addition to Carbonhill



I hereby certify the foregoing to be a correct plat of an addition to the town of Carbonhill, beginning 100 feet west of the Southeast corner of Fractional Lot No 3 in section No 21, Township No 13 Range No 15, Ohio Company's purchase Hocking County Ohio, being the South west corner of D Bairds as shown by plat thence West and passing the corner of sections 21 and 27 at 3.35 1/4 chains 12.44 3/4 chs to the SE corner of the town of Carbonhill, thence by the East line of said town 17.14 1/2 chains to the NE corner of the same thence East 13.96 1/2 chs to the North East corner of said addition, thence by the E. line of the same S. 15.62 3/4 to the NE corner of D. Bairds Lot thence N. 100 ft. thence S. 100 feet to beginning containing 23.71 acres. Said tract embraces 104 lots numbered from 160 to 263 inclusive, the dimensions of all lots Streets Avenues and Alleys are written on the plat in Links in proper order to designate Length and Breadth of Lots or widths of Streets, Avenues and Alleys - Given under my hand this 6th day of June 1881.
