For vacation of Carbon Hill.

Be it remembered that heretofore to wit on the 15 day of January 1878 came the above named persons by their attorney  
W. H. Rappaport and filed in the Clerk's office of said court their petition praying for the vacation of certain parts of the  
town of Carbon Hill which petition is in the words and figures following: That is to say, To the Honorable the  
Court of Common Pleas of Hocking County Ohio Your petitioners being the proprietors of the town plats herein  
after described respectively pray that the same may be vacated as follows to wit: 1<sup>st</sup> That so much of the town plat  
of the town of Carbon Hill as lies in Ward Township Hocking County in the State of Ohio made April 17, 1873  
and recorded in the recorder's office of said county on April 22 1873 as is embraced in in lots or said plat and  
in said town numbered one hundred and forty one, one hundred and forty two, one hundred and forty three  
one hundred & forty four, one hundred & forty five, one hundred & forty six and one hundred & forty seven  
(141, 142, 143, 144, 145, 146, 147) Together with so much of second street as lies between said Lots Numbers  
one hundred & forty one and one hundred & two (141, + 142) and so much of third street as lies east of and  
adjoining said lot No one hundred and forty seven (147) and the whole of the alley between said lots numbers  
one hundred & forty four and one hundred & forty five (144, 145) be vacated. 2<sup>nd</sup> That the whole of Crighton  
and Fallers addition to the above named town of Carbon Hill made on January 17<sup>th</sup> 1874 as designated  
upon the plat thereof recorded in the recorder's office of said Hocking County on January 19 1874 be vaca-  
ted and your petitioners represent that two of said above mentioned lots have been sold to wit: Numbers  
one hundred & forty two and one hundred & forty three (142 + 143) but no buildings has been erected thereon  
and that all the rest of said lots are owned by your petitioner that the whole of said addition and all the  
lots therein are owned by your petitioners no lots has been sold and no buildings erected in said addition  
and that the vacation of said plat in the manner above set forth is for the public interest and especially  
for the interest and benefit of the business of said town of Carbon Hill for the purpose of securing the necessary  
and suitable railroad facilities for said town. (Signed) Dson Finley } proprietors
