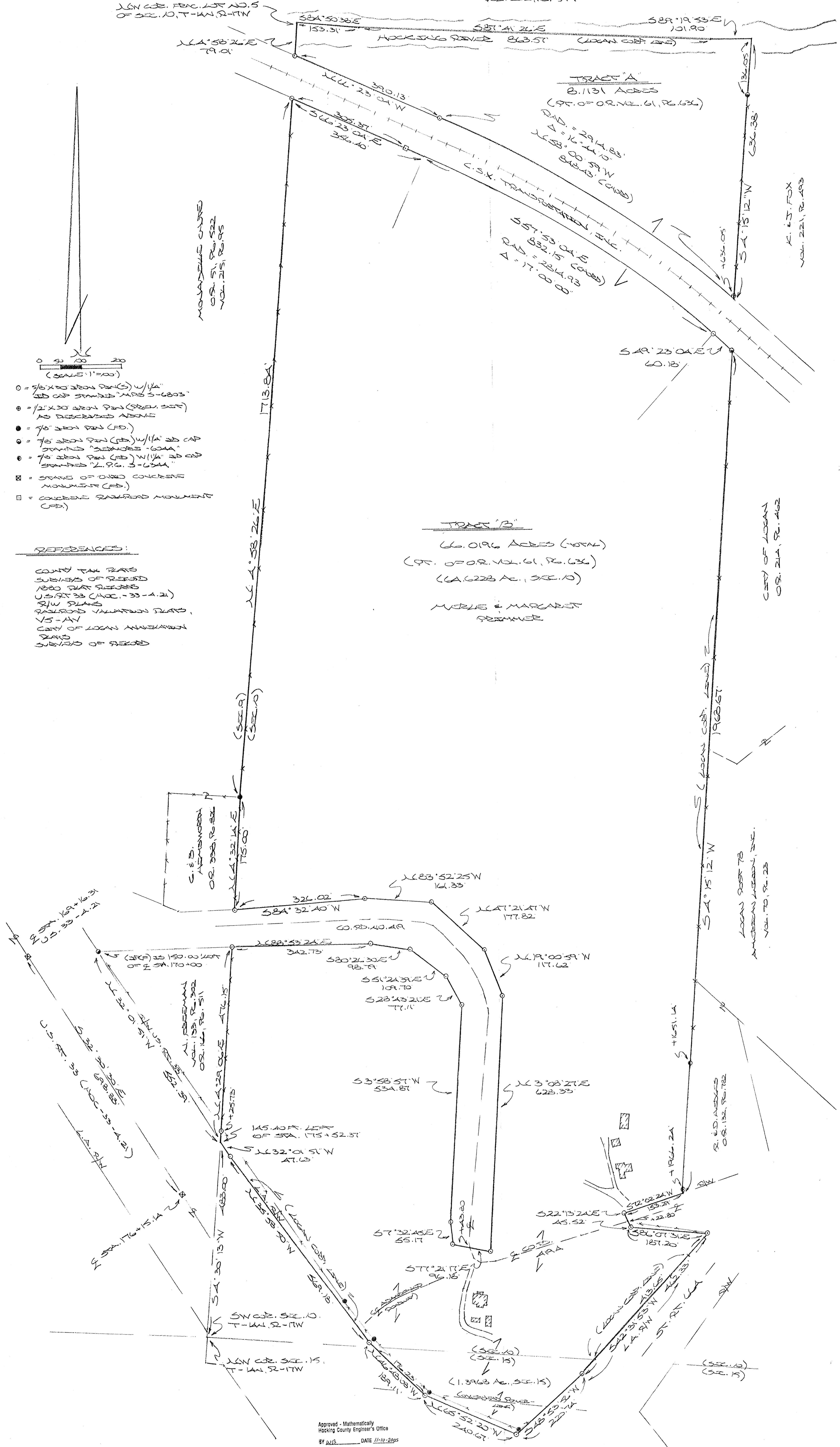

DESCRIPTION OF THE MERLE & MARGARET PRIMMER FARM

TRACT "A":

Being a part of the premises described in Vol. 61, Pg. 636, Hocking Co. Official Records, situated in Frac. Lot No. 5 of Sec. 10, Falls Twp., T-14N, R-17W, Hocking Co., Ohio, and being more particularly described as follows:

- 3) S 89 degrees 19' 53" E a distance of 101.90 ft. to a point on the east line of Frac. Lot No. 5;

SURVEY DESCRIPTION OF A 0.097 ACRE EASEMENT FOR LEROY SCRIBNER

Situated in Falls Township, Hocking County, Ohio; being part of Fractional Lots 10 and 11 of Section 10, Township 14, Range 17; and being more particularly described as follows:

Being part of a tract owned by the CSX Railroad.

Beginning at a 5/8" iron pin set at the Southeast corner of a 4.0297 acre tract and being on the north line of said CSX Railroad;

Thence leaving the north line of said CSX Railroad, South 22 degrees 15 minutes 12 seconds East a distance of 40.03 feet to a 5/8" iron pin set;




