

Also found a stump hole two feet southeasterly of the stone, and N 40° W., 11.2 feet (17 Links) from the stone is a white oak tree, 27.2 inches DBH, which is believed to be the original bearing tree called for by Levi Davis in 1868.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set 2"x48" iron pipe filled with concrete with a brass cap set in the top marked as shown. Monument set 1.5 feet west of stone and on Section line.
